AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF GREEN  
SPRING, KENTUCKY, CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED  
TERRITORY.


The Board of Trustees of the City of Green Spring does ordain  
as follows:

1. It being deemed to the best interests of the free-  
holders thereof and also to the best interest of the City of  
Green Spring, Kentucky, there is hereby annexed to the City  
of Green Spring that adjoining unincorporated territory in  
Jefferson County, Kentucky, and in the tract of land des-  
cribed with particularity as follows:

BEGINNING at a stone which is the most  
Southerly corner of the property conveyed  
to A. W. Bornhauser, recorded in Deed Book  
1773 Page 558. Said point also being in  
the line of a 90 acre tract partitioned to  
W. C. Barrickman in the division of the estate  
of William Barrickman, deceased, dated May 30,  
1905, and recorded in Deed Book 631 Page 106;  
thence with the line of the aforesaid tract  
North  $34^{\circ} 5' 30''$  West 1730, 37 feet to the  
right of way line of a road known as New  
Springdale Road, the right of way to which  
was conveyed by A. W. Bornhauser to the  
Commonwealth of Kentucky through its Depart-  
ment of Highways as part of a conveyance of  
the right of way of the Jefferson Freeway,  
which conveyance was made by Deed dated  
November 26, 1965 and recorded in Deed Book  
4006 Page 527. Thence with said right of way  
North  $84^{\circ} 33' 40''$  East 21.79 feet, South 670  
39' East 89.83 feet to a right of way monument.  
Thence continuing with said right of way  
South  $78^{\circ} 03'$  East 151.08 feet, thence South  
 $74^{\circ} 15'$  East 955.16 feet to a right of way  
monument, thence continuing with said right of  
way South  $68^{\circ} 58'$  East 50 feet thence South  
 $78^{\circ} 38'$  East 452.50 feet, thence South  $88^{\circ} 08'$   
East 50.10 feet to a right of way monument,  
thence continuing with said right of way South  
 $82^{\circ} 53'$  East 437.41 feet to a point. Said  
point being in the original Southeasterly line  
of the tract conveyed to A. W. Bornhauser by the  
aforesaid deed. Thence with said Southeasterly  
line South 55<sup>00</sup>' West 213.75 feet to a pipe,  
thence South  $36^{\circ} 30'$  East 12.54 feet to a pipe,  
thence South  $54^{\circ} 34'$  West 447.15 feet to a stone,  
thence South  $12^{\circ} 49'$  East 30.44 feet to a stone,  
thence South  $51^{\circ} 03'$  West 836.70 feet to the  
point of beginning.

2. This Ordinance shall be published as required by law and shall be effective upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
