


CERTIFICATION OF ORDINANCE NO. 110.50

ORDINANCE NUMBER 110.50

ORDINANCE ANNEXING PROPERTY INTO THE CITY LIMITS OF HARLAN

An Ordinance to annex to the City of Harlan, Kentucky certain unincorporated territory lying in Harlan County, Kentucky, and adjoining the corporate limits of said City, and accurately describing the boundary of the property to be annexed.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Harlan, Kentucky a City of the Fourth Class by virtue of Statutes of the State of Kentucky.

SECTION ONE: That it is hereby deemed advisable and it is hereby proposed to annex to the City of Harlan, Kentucky, all that unincorporated territory lying in Harlan County, Kentucky, and adjoining the corporate limits of said City, described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at the South West corner of the original "City of Harlan" boundary as established by Kentucky House bill #6 dated 3-13-1912 as taken from the "Glazier & Marlidge Engineers" map dated 12-06-1923, Said point has Kentucky Single Zone N.A.D. 83 coordinates of N:3474567.72, E:5629279.51;

Thence leaving the City of Harlan and with the outside boundary of the "Holly Point housing project property N 39°23'45" W 370.99; Thence S 55°08'27" W crossing Gilbert Hollow road DR # 1200Q at 400', a total distance of 751.65'; Thence S 07°2'-36" W 130.60'; Thence S 52°20'34" E 561.12'; Thence S 06°20'34" E 106.53'; Thence N 78°54'54" E 133.77" Thence N 67°38'28" E crossing Gilbert Hollow road CR # 1200Q at 90' a total distance of 102.27'; Thence N 67°35'00" E 22.45'; Thence with a curve to the left with an arc length of 520.92'; a radius of 607.96' a chord bearing of N 43 30'30" E, and a chord length of, crossing March Street at 325', a total distance of 496.01'; Thence N 19°25'59" E 126.98; Thence N 73' 12'11" E 60.02'; Thence N 19°25'59" E 126.98'; Thence N 73'12'11" E 60.02; Thence No 28°04'03" E 200.19' to the South line of the original City of Harlan city limits; Thence with said City limits N 67°00'00" W 185.00' to the beginning.

Containing 67211305 sq. ft., or 15.430 acres and being all of the property encompassed in the "Holly Point" housing project

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall be published three times in the Harlan Daily Enterprise, a newspaper of general circulation in Harlan County, Kentucky, published in the City of Harlan, Kentucky, as provided by law.

SECTION THREE: ALL ORDINANCES, or parts of Ordinance, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION FIVE: This Ordinance shall take effect when signed, recorded and published as required by law.

The forgoing Annexation Ordinance was read and presented to the Harlan City Council at its Regular Meeting on November 12, 1984. Roberta Donahue then made the motion for adoption, which was seconded by James Croushorn.
