JUDGMENT

This action having come on to be heard on Motion of the petitioners, Jack E. Gerke, Theda Jagers, William D. Kavich, Harvey E. Willis, Kenneth C. Young, Jr., Willard Mahan, S. T. Meler, Suzanne Hardison, and others listed on Exhibit A of the Petition filed herein, to enter a Judgment herein establishing the City of Hickory Hill, located in Jefferson County, Kentucky, and it appearing to the Court that the form of said proposed city is square; that said proposed city does not exceed one-half (1/2) mile in each direction; that at least 125 inhabitants reside within the boundaries of the proposed city; and that the petition filed herein was signed by at least two-thirds (2/3) of the qualified voters living within the boundaries of the proposed city; that notice of filing of the petition and the objects of this suit were duly published in two issues of The Courier-Journal, a daily newspaper of general circulation in Jefferson County Kentucky; and no defense or objections having been interposed to said incorporation and the Court being sufficiently advised, it is now ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the City of Hickory Hill be, and the same hereby is established a City of the Sixth Class under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky and that the boundaries of said city are as follows:

Beginning at a point (PK nail in the pavement) in the centerline of Westport Road said point being the Northeast corner of a tract conveyed to the William Watkins Memorial Methodist Church by Deed of Record in DB 3759 P 310 in the Office of the Clerk of the County Court of Jefferson County, Kentucky; thence along the centerline

of Westport Road N56° 07' 53"E 606.16 feet to a point on the centerline of Westport Road (PK nail in the pavement) said point being the northwest corner of a tract conveyed to Anthony and Allene Pohl by Deed of Record in DB 2114 P 160 in the office aforesaid; thence along the westerly line of the same S20° 32' 10"E 1321.66 feet to a pipe at the Southwest corner of the Pohl tract aforesaid and being the northerly line of a tract conveyed to the Commonwealth of Kentucky by Deed of Record in DB 223 P 362 & DB 2599 P 501 in the office aforesaid; thence along the northerly line of the same S61° 41' 58"W 540.78 feet to a pipe at the southeast corner of the tract conveyed to the Watkins Memorial Church by Deed of Record in DB 3759 P 310 in the office aforesaid; thence along the easterly line of the same N23° 00' 00"W 1256.10 feet to the point of beginning. Containing 16.8 acres divided into 55 lots.

The above described subdivision recorded in SPB 29 P 75 and amended and replatted by minor plat of record in DB 4589 P 494, 495, 496, 497, 498 & 499.

The following voters residing within said area are appointed as officials of the City of Hickory Hill to fill the office set out following their respective names:
