WHEREFORE, in accordance with Petitioners' prayer herein for the establishment and incorporation of the proposed Sixth Class City of Hills And Dales, to be located within Jefferson County, Kentucky, proper notice of the incorporation of the proposed City having been given by publication, and no defense having been interposed in regard to the incorporation of the proposed City, the Court having been duly advised that Petitioners have satisfied all requisites for the incorporation of Sixth Class Cities for the Commonwealth of Kentucky, as set forth in Chapter 81 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes.

The Court hereby orders and adjudges as follows:

1. That on this date there is established a City of the Sixth Class located within Jefferson County, Kentucky, which by this Judgment is hereby named

CITY OF HILLS AND DALES

2. That the boundaries of said City are as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the South line of Hills and Dales recorded in Plat and Subdivision Book 14, Page 22, in the office of the Clerk of the County Court of Jefferson County, Kentucky, said point being North 52 degrees 30 minutes East 568.76 feet from the East line of U. S. Highway #42 as widened; thence with the South line of Hills and Dales, North 52 degrees 30 minutes East, 1662.81 feet to a point in the Easterly corner of Lot 7 Hills and Dales aforementioned;

thence with the Easterly line of Hills and Dales and a straight extension thereof, North 37 degrees 30 minutes West, 1662.81 feet to a point; thence South 52 degrees 30 minutes East passing through the North corner of Lot #17 Hills and Dales aforesaid at 334.19 feet and crossing U. S. Highway #42, in all 1662.81 feet to a point; thence South 37 degrees 30 minutes East and recrossing U. S. Highway #42 1662.81 feet to the point of beginning and containing 63.47 acres or 0.0991 Square Miles.

3. That the following persons, whose names and addresses appear below are appointed to the respective offices of the City of Hills And Dales set opposite each of their names, and that each of such persons hold his respective office until the next election at which officers may be elected for the Sixth Class City of Hills And Dales herein established.

That until the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky has assigned the City herein established to the class to which it belongs, all general laws relating to Cities of the Sixth Class shall apply to the City of Hills And Dales, herein established, and hereafter said City shall enjoy all rights, powers and privileges accorded to cities of whatever class the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky shall assign unto it.

5. Pursuant to KRS 81.060, not later than ten (10) days after the entry of the Judgment herein, the Clerk of the Jefferson Circuit Court is directed to certify a copy of the Judgment herein to the Secretary of State of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, whose duty it shall be to properly index and file the same as a permanent record in his office.
