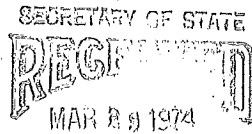

JUDGMENT

WHEREAS, Richard W. Doran, John G. Stambro, Timothy Carl Bradshaw and 338 other petitioners have filed a petition to incorporate a city to be known as Hillview, Kentucky, pursuant to the provisions of KRS 81.040, 81.050 and 81.060, and

WHEREAS, the boundary of the proposed city does not exceed one-half mile in each direction, the form of the city being square and containing in excess of 125 inhabitants, and

WHEREAS, at least two-thirds of the voters living within the boundary of the proposed city have petitioned for its incorporation, and

WHEREAS, notice of the filing of the petition and of its object has been given by publication pursuant to KRS Chapter 424, and the Court being otherwise sufficiently advised,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED THAT

1. The following described property situated in Bullitt County, Kentucky, be and hereby is incorporated into a city bearing the name of Hillview, Kentucky.

Beginning at a point in the Easterly right of way line of Blossom Road, said point being the Northwest corner of Lot 77, Maryville Subdivision Section "M" recorded in Plat Book 3, Page 17, in the office of the Clerk of the County Court of Bullitt County, Kentucky; thence with said Easterly line of Blossom Road, and same extended in a Northeasterly direction, North 18 degrees 10 minutes East 2640 feet to a point; thence South 71 degrees 50 minutes East 2640 feet to a point; thence South 18 degrees 10 minutes West 2640 feet to a point; thence North 71 degrees 50 minutes West 2640 feet to the point of beginning.

2. Pursuant to the desire of the petitioners and KRS 81.060, the following qualified voters within the incorporated area be and hereby are appointed to hold the following offices until the next election at which officers for cities and towns may be elected:

Trustees: Sidney Charles Phipps, Timothy Carl Bradshaw, John Glen Stambro, Robert Lee Stickland, Sr., Mary Yvonne Doran.


Police Judge: Richard William Doran

Assessor: Danny Dale Hopkins

Marshal: Billy Ray Fraley

3. The Clerk of this Court shall, not later than ten days from the date hereof, certify a copy hereof to the Secretary of State of Kentucky.

4. This is a Final Judgment effective from the date hereof.
