

ORDINANCE NO. 94-20

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY ADJOINING THE CITY OF HILLVIEW, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

The City Council of the City of Hillview, Bullitt County, Kentucky, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION I: The City Council of the City of Hillview, Bullitt County, Kentucky, does hereby annex certain unincorporated territory to the City of Hillview, Bullitt County, Kentucky, and such territory shall become a part of the City for all purposes under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and such territory annexed is described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point, said point being in the boundary of the City of Hillview (Ordinance No. 87-7) where it intersects the east right of way of Interstate 65 in the Northeast quadrant of the Brooks Road Interchange; thence with the east right of way of Interstate 65 in a northerly direction 1320' to a field division fence (cultivated field/pasture field); thence with the field division fence in an easterly direction 1220'; thence following the fence in a southerly direction (behind the current barn, tool shed and tobacco barn) to a point in the existing boundary of the City of Hillview, containing approximately 32 acres, more or less.

SECTION II: The City Council of the City of Hillview, Bullitt County, Kentucky, does find the property described above is of an urban character which is suitable for development purposes without unreasonable delay and does hereby declare it desirable to annex into the City of Hillview.

SECTION III: The Mayor of the City of Hillview, Bullitt County, Kentucky, having received prior written consent of each owner of record of the land herein before described requesting annexation into the City of Hillview, and all provisions of KRS 81A.412 having been complied with, the herein before described property is annexed into the City of Hillview, Bullitt County, Kentucky.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall be published according to law.


SECTION V: This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to KRS 81A.400, et.seq.

SECTION VI: Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.


