

ORDINANCE NO. 94-30

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY ADJOINING THE CITY OF HILLVIEW, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

The City Council of the City of Hillview, Bullitt County, Kentucky, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION I: The City Council of the City of Hillview, Bullitt County, Kentucky, does hereby annex certain unincorporated territory to the City of Hillview, Bullitt County, Kentucky, and such territory shall become a part of the City for all purposes under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and such territory annexed is described as follows:

TRACT I:

BEGINNING at an iron pipe at a wood fence post in the northern corner of Claude Fontaine (Deed Book 121, Page 28, office of the Clerk of the Bullitt County Court) and the edge of Blue Lick Road (Kentucky Highway 1450) thence along said highway north 19 degrees 39' E 111.3 feet; thence north 15 degrees 50' E 119.3 feet; thence north 6 degrees 04' E 94.5 feet; thence N 0 degrees 37' W 68.0 feet to an iron pipe at a wood post; thence south 83 degrees 56' E 33.9 feet to a wood fence post; thence north 19 degrees 22' 50" E 507.0 feet to a wood fence post; thence south 71 degrees 07' 32" E 724.0 feet to a wood fence post; thence south 18 degrees 51' 50" W 889.1 feet to an iron pipe at a wood fence post; thence north 72 degrees 05' 50" W 713.4 feet to the point of beginning and containing 14.904 acres as per survey of C. E. Pence (R. L. S. 2032) dated March 17, 1986.

TRACT II:

BEGINNING at a stone in the East line of Blue Lick Road, said point also being a Southwest corner of a tract conveyed to George Wise, etc., by deed recorded in Deed Book 62, Page 571 in the office of the Clerk of the County Court of Bullitt County, Kentucky; thence from the point of beginning, with line of fence South 68° 45' East, 615.0 feet to a pipe; thence South 21° 15' West 357 feet, more or less, to a pipe; thence North 75° 27' West, 280 feet to a pipe; thence North 70° 25' West, 352 feet to a pipe in the East line of Blue Lick Road; thence with the East line of Blue Lick Road North 23° 10' East, 400.00 feet to the point of beginning, containing 5.4 acres, more or less.

SECTION II: The City Council of the City of Hillview, Bullitt County, Kentucky, does find the property described above is of an urban character which is suitable for development purposes without unreasonable delay and does hereby declare it desirable to annex into the City of Hillview.

SECTION III: The Mayor of the City of Hillview, Bullitt County, Kentucky, having received prior written consent of each owner of record of the land herein before described requesting annexation into the City of Hillview, and all provisions of KRS 81A.412 having been complied with, the herein before described property is annexed into the City of Hillview, Bullitt County, Kentucky.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall be published according to law.


SECTION V: This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to KRS 81A.400, et.seq.

SECTION VI: Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.


