This action having come on for a hearing on order of the Court, and it appearing to the Court that notices of same have been given in accordance with the Order of the Court, and it further appearing to the Court, and the Court being sufficiently advised on the Petition herein, that the property within the described boundaries of said city is sufficient to meet the said requirements of law which govern the creation of Sixth (6th) Class cities, and the Court being sufficiently advised,

IT IS ORDERED and ADJUDGED AS follows:

1. That a city to be known as HOLLOW CREEK, KENTUCKY, be and the same hereby is established as a municipal corporation of the Sixth (6th) Class city within the following described boundaries shown on the map filed with the Petition filed herein, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the most Northerly line of LOT NUMBER 168 HOLLOW CREEK SUBDIVISION, SECTION NUMBER 3, recorded in P. & S.B. 21, Page 87 in the Office of the Clerk of the County Court of Jefferson County, Kentucky; said point being further described as North 46 degrees, 40 minutes West, 11.87 feet from the most Northeasterly corner of said Lot Number 168; Thence South 46 degrees, 40 minutes East, 1,320.00 feet to a point in HOLLOW CREEK SUBDIVISION SECTION NUMBER 4, recorded in P. & S.B. 23, Page 28 in the abovementioned Clerk's office; thence South 43 degrees, 20 minutes West, 1,320.00 feet to a point in HOLLOW CREEK SUBDIVISION SECTION NUMBER 5 recorded in P. & S.B. 24, Page 68 in the abovementioned Clerk's office; thence North 46 degrees, 40 minutes West, 1,320.00 feet to a point in HOLLOW CREEK SUBDIVISION SECTION NUMBER 1-C recorded in P. & S.B. 20, Page 69 in the abovementioned Clerk's office; thence North 43 degrees, 20 minutes East, 1,320.00 feet to the point of beginning and containing 0.0625 Square Miles.




All of the Trustees and Officers above appointed, shall hold their respective offices until the next election of the officers of cities and towns may be held.

3. The Clerk of the Court, not later than ten (10) days after Judgment is entered herein shall certify a copy of this Judgment to the Secretary of State of Frankfort, Kentucky, whose duty it shall be to properly enter and file the same in the Secretary of State's office.
