### **ORDINANCE NO. 13-98**

### AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY INTO THE CITY OF HOPKINSVILLE, KENTUCKY

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOPKINSVILLE, AS FOLLOWS:

### **SECTION ONE**

The City Council of the City of Hopkinsville does hereby state and declare an area described in Exhibit A to be annexed into the City limits of Hopkinsville. Exhibit A is attached hereto and incorporated herein by the reference as if fully set forth.

### **SECTION TWO**

Pursuant to House Bill 466 adopted in the 1994 Kentucky General Assembly, that amended KRS 81A.412 to permit "consent annexation," all property owners involved have requested to be annexed immediately into the City of Hopkinsville under said house bill and no Ordinance of Intent is required.

### **SECTION THREE**

The area of property to be annexed is:

A. Adjacent to current City of Hopkinsville boundaries and has contiguous boundaries to the current City of Hopkinsville limits at the time of these annexation proceedings.

- B. Urban in character or suitable for further urban development without unreasonable delay.
  - C. Not included within the boundary of another incorporated city.

### **SECTION FOUR**

The City Council of the City of Hopkinsville declares that the service delivery plan and City taxes will be in effect on the 1st day after publication of this ordinance.

### **SECTION FIVE**

Any and all existing ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are repealed.

### **SECTION SIX**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such infirmities shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

### **SECTION SEVEN**

This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, approval and publication according to law.

### LEGAL DESCRIPTION PROPOSED ANNEXATION OF 204.43 ACRES INTO THE CITY OF HOPKINSVILLE, KY

### PARCELL

Beginning at a 5/8 inch rebar and cap found in the south right-of-way of US 41 and being the northwest corner of the Hopkinsville Industrial Foundation, Inc. lands, (refer to DB 539-P 676), said rebar bears North 56 degrees 42 minutes 58 seconds West, 733.90 feet from the west right-of-way Frank Yost Lane;

Thence, with the west line of the Hopkinsville Industrial Foundation, Inc. lands, South 38 degrees 01 minutes 33 seconds West, 401.20 feet;

Thence, South 38 degrees 00 minutes 29 seconds West, 541.69 feet;

Thence, South 38 degrees 01 minutes 51 seconds West, 1993.99 feet to a 5/8 inch rebar and cap found in the north right-of-way of CSX Railroad;

Thence, with the north line of said railroad, North 59 degrees 39 minutes 44 seconds West, 1039,30 feet to a 5/8 inch rebar and cap set;

Thence, North 59 degrees 39 minutes 44 seconds West, 1664.17 feet to a 5/8 inch rebar and cap set;

Thence, North 59 degrees 39 minutes 44 seconds West, 839.25 feet;

Thence, North 30 degrees 17 minutes 29 seconds East, 17.00 feet;

Thence, North 59 degrees 42 minutes 31 seconds West, 37.00 feet;

Thence a curve to the right having a radius of 4607.98 feet, are length of 129.13 feet and long chord bears North 61 degrees 36 minutes 01 seconds West, 129.13 feet;

Thence leaving said railroad and with a severence line through the Means & Fort Electric, Inc. lands, North 70 degrees 59 minutes 27 seconds East, 1766.06 feet;

Thence, North 36 degrees 28 minutes 01 seconds East, 845.47 feet at the southerly corner of the Jeff Burkhead lands, (DB 469 - P 679);

Thence, with the east line of the said Jeff Burkhead 10 acre tract, North 36 degrees 28 minutes 01 seconds East, 889.92 feet to a 1/2 inch rebar found in the south right-of-way of US 41;

Thence, with the said road right-of-way, a curve to the left, having a radius of 4815.81 feet, length of 187.41 feet, and long chord bears South 55 degrees 34 minutes 26 seconds East, 187.40 feet;

Thence, South 56 degrees 41 minutes 19 seconds East, 333.45 feet;

Thence, North 33 degrees 18 minutes 41 seconds East, 10.00 feet;




