Pursuant to KRS 83A 040(8) and 118.305(7), I hereby notify you Councilman Joe Nunn, Jr., (Ward 11) passed away Friday, March 17, 2000, succumbing to cancer. Mr. Nunn, 71, served just over 16 consecutive years on Hopkinsville City Council. He was first elected in 1983, when Hopkinsville transitioned to a ward system and has been the only Councilman ever to serve Ward 11. Only two other Council members have served longer terms, since the City adopted the Mayor-Council form of government.

Mr. Nunn served with five Mayors and was Mayor Pro Tem in 1999.

Joe always wanted to do what was in the community's best interest. He never aspired to be the leader of a cause or project, but I know many other council members sought his counsel before deciding if they would support or oppose various issues.

As for me personally, I will deeply miss the many hours we spent together on the City's behalf. His sense of humor, as well as his sense of fairness and concern for all, always help take the edge off the issues at hand and make our work more pleasant. I will miss his presence, but his influence will continue to set the standard for fairness and dedication to the public here at City Hall.
