This action having come on to be heard on Motion of the
Petitioners, Troy T. Beasley, Robert E. Maxwell, Marshal Maxwell,
Judy D. Hardesty, Marijane Robinson McBride, Loa Robinson, Robert
Staples, Donald C. Jackson, Phyllis W. Jackson, William K. Justice,
Jr., Mary Alicia Justice, June Beasley, Holly F. Beasley, Randall W.
Hardesty, Linda S. Parker; Ronald H. Parker, Roderick D. Tindle,
Nancy A. Parsons, Sam R. Myers, Carolyn P. Myers, George T. Daniels,
John Ramey, Naomi Ramey, and Helen D. Staples, to enter a Judgment
herein establishing the City of Hunters Hollow, located in Bullitt
County, Kentucky, and it appearing to the Court that the form of
the said proposed city is an approximate square; that the said
proposed city does not exceed one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) mile in each direction;
that at least 125 inhabitants reside within the boundaries of the
proposed city; and that the petition filed herein was signed by at
least two-thirds ($\frac{2}{3}$) of the qualified voters living within the
boundaries of the proposed city; that notice of filing of the
petition and the objects of this suit were duly published in one
issue of the Courier-Journal, a daily newspaper of general cir-
culation in Bullitt County, Kentucky, and in the Louisville Times,

a daily newspaper of general circulation in Bullitt County,

Kentucky; and no defense ~~or objections~~ having been interposed
and the court having noted and considered and overruled
to said incorporation, and the Court being sufficiently advised,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED, that the
City of Hunters Hollow be, and the same is hereby established a
City of the Sixth (6th) Class under the laws of the Commonwealth
of Kentucky and that the boundaries of said city are as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the Southerly right-of-way
line of Marvyille Drive at its intersection with the
Westerly line of the tract conveyed to Jeffie Lee by
Deed Book 62, Page 406; thence along said Southerly
right-of-way line of Maryville Drive South 71 degrees
45 minutes East 1057.51 feet; thence leaving Maryville
Drive, South 40 degrees 38 minutes West 913.65 feet and
South 42 degrees 46 minutes 03 seconds West 778.01 feet
to a point in the aforesaid westerly line of the tract
conveyed to Jeffie Lee; thence along said westerly
line, the following courses and distances; North 17
degrees 46 minutes West 400 feet; North 20 degrees 31
minutes West 92 feet; North 21 degrees, 57 minutes
85 feet; North 25 degrees 50 minutes West 100.70 feet;
North 64 degrees 10 minutes East 135.76 feet; and
North 17 degrees 44 minutes East 844.81 feet to the
point of beginning, and being Tract 2 as shown on
plat attached to and made a part of a mortgage dated
June 14, 1973, of record in Mortgage Book 94, Page 628.

as officials of the City of Hunters Hollow to fill the office set
