ORDINANCE NO. 2007-O-18

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, ANNEXING PART OF THE TERRITORY KNOWN AS 5106 MADISON PIKE, INDEPENDENCE, KENTUCKY, SAID PROPERTY OWNED BY THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE AS ACQUIRED BY DEED BOOK 325, PAGE 305 OF THE KENTON COUNTY CLERK'S RECORDS AT INDEPENDENCE, SAID TERRITORY BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED HEREINAFTER.

WHEREAS, The City of independence adopted Ordinance No. 2007-O-05 which was an Ordinance of Intent to Annex territory known as 5106 Madison Pike, Independence, Kentucky, said property owned by the United States Postal Service as acquired by deed book 325, page 305 of the Kenton County Clerk's records at Independence, said territory being more particularly described in Exhibit 'A' attached hereto, and

WHEREAS, the appropriate amount of time for objection/appeal/remonstrance to such intent having passed with the City of Independence not having been notified of any such action;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

The City of Independence hereby annexes the unincorporated territory known as 5106 Madison Pike, Independence, Kentucky, said property owned by the United States Postal Service as acquired by deed book 325, page 305 of the Kenton County Clerk's records at Independence described in the attachment hereto.

SECTION II

The territory which is the subject of this ordinance is more accurately and completely described and illustrated in Exhibit 'A', attached to this Ordinance. The exhibit accurately defines the boundary of the territory proposed to be annexed.

SECTION III

It is desirable for the City of Independence to annex said property.

SECTION IV

This ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption and approval according to law, and publication thereafter.

SECTION V

All ordinances or parts of any ordinances in conflict herewith, to the extent of the conflict, if any, are hereby repealed.

SECTION VI

The foregoing Ordinance was read, passed and adopted by the Council of the City of Independence, Kentucky, meeting in a Regular Session held on the 1st day of October 2007, with 6 yes votes, 0 No votes, and ___ Abstentions, and was thereafter approved by the Mayor and order published in Summary according to law.


