JUDGMENT

This cause coming on to be heard on Petition of the City of Jeffersontown, Kentucky, a city of the fourth class, and the exhibits thereto, including consent to annexation of all parties having a right of remonstrance; and no remonstrance having been filed herein, and no order for granting future time for making defense having been entered herein; and this Court finding that all requirements of K.R.S. 81.210 applicable to said annexation have been complied with,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

1. That a tract of land hereinafter described be, and hereby is, annexed to the corporate limits of the City of Jeffersontown, Kentucky, and that the city boundary of the City of Jeffersontown, Kentucky, is extended to include therein the following tract of land, to-wit:

BEGINNING at the Northeast corner of a tract of land conveyed to Noble Lillard by Deed recorded in Deed Book 2355, page 349, recorded in the office of the County Court Clerk of Jefferson County, Kentucky; said point being the point of intersection of the South line of

Interstate Highway No. 64 with the West line of Watterson Trail; continuing thence with the Southerly right of way of Interstate 64 to the East line of Watterson Trail, said point being coincident with the City boundary line as established by Ordinance No. 396, Series 1964; thence Southwestwardly with the Easterly line of Watterson Trail and the City boundary line as established as aforesaid to its point of intersection with the center line of Moser Road (now closed); continuing thence along the former center line of Moser Road and the City boundary line as established by Ordinance No. 381, Series 1964, Northwardly to a point in the South line of Interstate 64; thence with the said South line of Interstate 64 Eastwardly to the point of beginning.

2. That the Clerk of this Court shall immediately certify this Judgment to the City Council of the City of Jeffersontown, Kentucky, who shall immediately enter this Judgment on its records.

3. That the cost of this action shall be paid by the City of Jeffersontown, Kentucky.
