JUDGMENT

* * * * *

This cause coming on to be heard on Petition of the City of Jeffersontown, Kentucky, a city of the Fourth Class, and the exhibits thereto, including consent of the sole owners of the land sought to be annexed, and no remonstrance having been filed herein, and no order for granting future time for making defense having been entered herein; and this Court finding that all requirements of K.R.S. 81.210 applicable to said annexation have been complied with,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

1. That a tract of land hereinafter described be, and hereby is, annexed to the corporate limits of the City of Jeffersontown, Kentucky, and that the city boundary of the City of Jeffersontown, Kentucky, is extended to include therein the following tract of land, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the Easterly right-of-way line of Watterson Trail, said point being South 88 degrees 15 minutes 16 seconds East of the Southwesternmost corner of the tract conveyed to Highbaugh Enterprises, Incorporated, by Deed of record in Deed Book 4768, page 311, said point being also in the line of the existing City of Jeffersontown, Kentucky, boundary as established by Ordinance No. 381, Series 1964; thence along said right-of-way line and boundary line North 4 degrees 43 minutes 34 seconds East 207.12 feet to a point; thence North 12 degrees 11 minutes 14 seconds East 59.58 feet to a point; thence North 12 degrees 11 minutes 14 seconds East 395.48 feet, more or less, to

an iron pipe in the Eastern right-of-way line of Watterson Trail and the existing City boundary line aforesaid; thence South 77 degrees 48 minutes 46 seconds East 35 feet to an iron pipe; thence South 12 degrees 11 minutes 14 seconds West 395.48 feet; thence along a curve to the left having a radius of 50 feet and a chord of South 34 degrees 02 minutes 36 seconds East 72.21 feet to a point; thence South 80 degrees 16 minutes 26 seconds East 101.32 feet to an iron pipe; thence along a curve to the left having a radius of 1,072.84 feet and a chord of North 87 degrees 19 minutes 37 seconds East 460.72 feet to a point; thence North 74 degrees 55 minutes 41 seconds East 401.41 feet to a stone in the Easterly line of the Highbaugh Enterprises, Inc. tract aforesaid and being in a Westerly line of Highbaugh Enterprises, Inc., Deed Book 4654, page 290; thence North 16 degrees 50 minutes 33 seconds West 1,529.46 feet, more or less to a stone; thence North 77 degrees 25 minutes 19 seconds East 1,785.79 feet to a stone; thence North 74 degrees 26 minutes 05 seconds East 873.76 feet to a pipe; thence South 18 degrees 11 minutes 04 seconds East passing a stone at 4.29 feet, in all 854.67 feet to a pin; thence South 74 degrees 11 minutes 49 seconds West 892.33 feet to a pipe; thence South 16 degrees 55 minutes 33 seconds East 512.93 feet to a pipe; thence the following courses and distances: South 68 degrees 04 minutes 27 seconds West 295 feet to a pipe, South 66 degrees 22 minutes 02 seconds West 206.39 feet to a pipe, South 54 degrees 18 minutes 45 seconds West 130 feet to a pipe, South 21 degrees 18 minutes 45 seconds West 260 feet to a pipe, and South 75 degrees 18 minutes 45 seconds West 1,001.23 feet to a stake; thence South 75 degrees 18 minutes 54 seconds West passing a pipe at 20.01 feet, in all 1,334.75 feet, more or less, to the Easterly line of Watterson Trail and the existing City boundary lines established aforesaid; thence with the Easterly line of same and the existing City boundary lines established aforesaid, North 2 degrees 57 minutes 24 seconds East 651.17 feet to the beginning; all records in the office of the County Clerk of Jefferson County, Kentucky.

2. That the Clerk of this Court shall immediately certify this Judgment to the City Council of the City of Jeffersontown, Kentucky, who shall immediately enter this Judgment on its records.

3. That the cost of this action shall be paid by the City of Jeffersontown, Kentucky.

This is a Final Judgment.

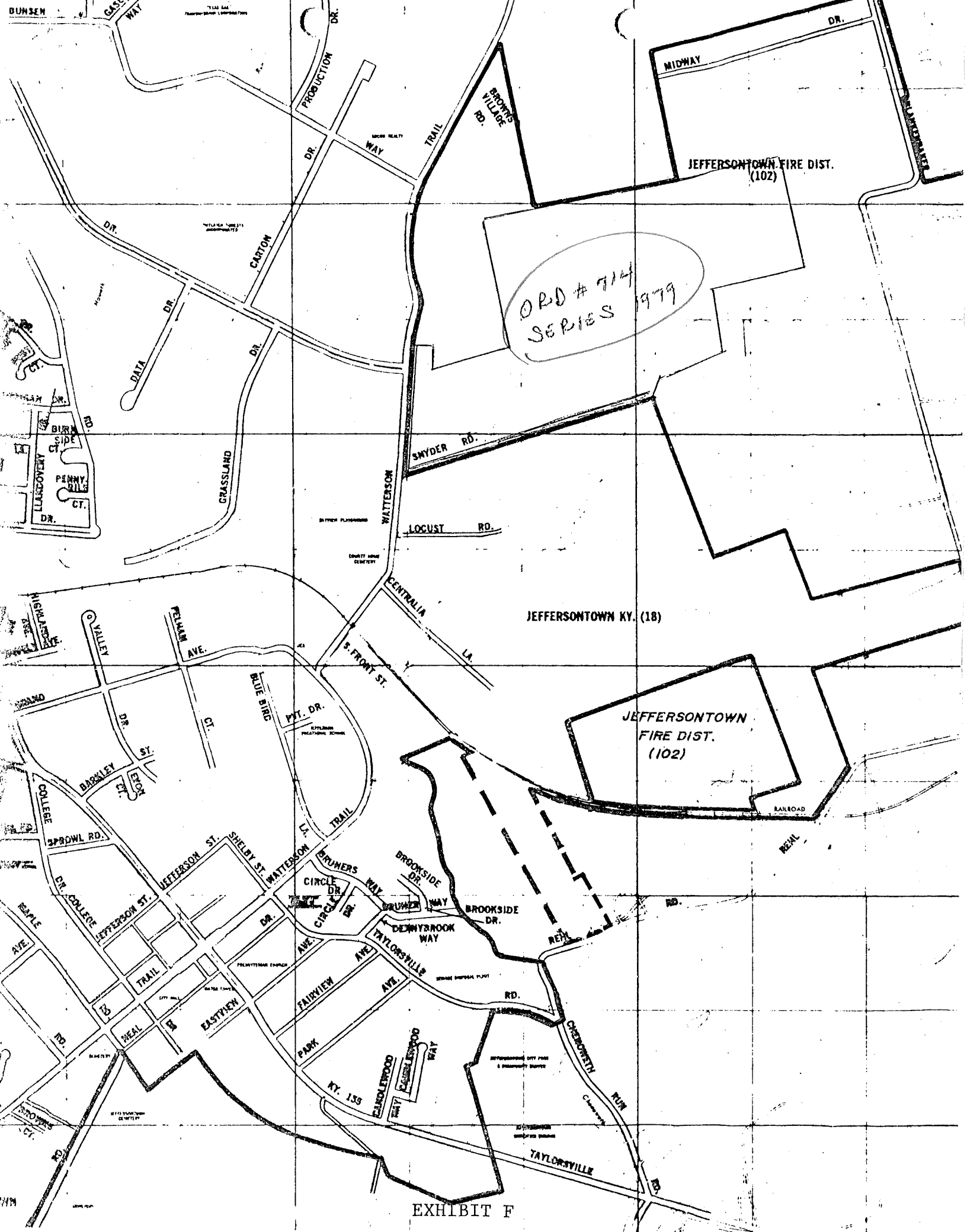
