RESOLUTION

COMES NOW City Council of Jenkins KY and hereby Resolves as follows:

WHEREAS it has come to City Councils attention that Mayor Todd Depriest has been temporarily rendered incapable of carrying out his duties as Mayor due to medical reasons, and

WHEREAS City Council needs to ensure that the City can operate in his absence without delay or interruption.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to KRS 83A.130 (7) and City Ordinance 31.21, the City Council hereby resolves and appoints City Clerk April Moore and City Bookkeeper Robin Kincer to serve as co-protem Mayors.

That City Council further vest in these Co-protem Mayors all Executive and Administrative powers that the Mayor could have exercised should he not be under the current temporary disability this would include but not be limited to financial and personnel matters.

That the City Council further vest in the Co-protem Mayors the power to assume Mayors position as agent or correspondent in all levels of funding, performance or certifications of any grant applications or operating grants held by the City.

That this appointment of Co-protem Mayors shall last till the Mayor can issue an Executive Order making such arrangements as he sees fit to delegate the powers granted herein or to resume his duties in his own right.

That the City Clerk is directed to notify Letcher County Clerk and Secretary of State of this Resolution.
