ORDINANCE NO. 1981-2

COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY AS PART OF THE CITY OF KEVIL, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, M. T. Bowles and wife, Ruth Bowles, and Lois Trice, each owners of property outside the corporate limits of the City of Kevil, Kentucky, have come forward requesting that their properties be annexed into the City of Kevil and

WHEREAS, the City of Kevil does believe it would be advantageous and beneficial to the City to annex said territory into said City, then now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Kevil, Kentucky

Section 1. That the territory hereinbelow described adjacent to the South City Limits of the City of Kentucky be annexed and taken into the corporate limits of the City of Kevil, Kentucky, said territory to be annexed is described by meets and bounds as follows:

Beginning at a stake in the South right-of-way line of U. S. Highway 60 across from the intersection of U. S. Highway 60 and Kentucky Highway 473, the Kevil-Woodville Road, corner to Hook and at a railroad spike thence North 69 deg. 30 min. West 372.45 feet to a stake, thence South 2 deg. 43 min. West 228.4 ft. to a stake, thence South 85 deg. 11 min. East 325.9 ft. to ~~stake~~, a corner post; thence North 13 deg. 4 min. East 36 ft. to a stake; thence South 69 deg. 30 min. East 26.4 ft. to an iron pin; thence North 1 deg. 15 min. ~~West~~ 99.9 feet to a ~~stake~~, the point of beginning and being the outside boundary of property owned by M. T. Bowles and Lois Trice containing 1.434 acres all according to survey of John K. Kelly made on June 9, 1981. *see plat recorded at*

Section 2. The above described territory from and after the date of enactment of this Ordinance shall be considered a part of the corporate limits of the City of Kevil, Kentucky.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption and publication in one issue of the Advance-Yoeman, Wickliffe, Kentucky a newspaper of general circulation in Ballard County, Kentucky.
