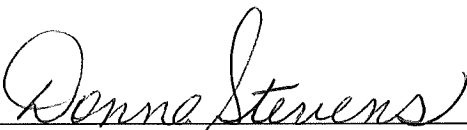

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING A PORTION OF THE JOHNSON ADDITION
INTO THE CITY OF KEVIL, KENTUCKY. file

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KEVIL, KENTUCKY:

1. It is the intent of the City of Kevil, Kentucky, to ^{300-K Kevil}
annex the following described tract of land, said property being ^{GEN. - unincorporated (misc.)}
unincorporated and it is desirable that said property be annexed
into the City of Kevil, Kentucky.

2. The property to be annexed is described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the West line of Johnson Addition to Kevil, Kentucky, as recorded in Plat Book "B", Page 43 of the Ballard County Court Clerk's Office at its intersection with the City Limits of Kevil, said point being 150 feet North of the North right-of-way line of U. S. Highway 60 and 350 feet West of the West right-of-way line of Johnson Drive; THENCE FROM SAID POINT OF BEGINNING N 15° 30' E with the West line of aforesaid Johnson Addition approximately 811 feet to the Northwest corner thereof; thence S 74° 10' E with the North line of Johnson Addition approximately 775 feet to the Northeast corner thereof; thence S 15° 30' W with the East line of said Johnson Addition approximately 822 feet to the point in the aforesaid City Limits; thence N 75° W parallel with the North right-of-way line of U. S. Highway 60 and 150 feet Northwardly therefrom, approximately 775 feet to the point of beginning and containing approximately 14.5 acres, according to survey dated July 8, 1987, by Rod H. Martin, Kentucky Land Surveyor.

A PORTION OF JOHNSON ADDITION

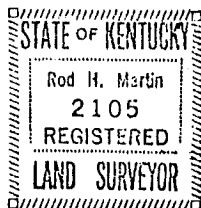
TO BE ANNEXED BY

Highway 60, East of Kentucky Highway 472 (Woodville Road) and being the Northerly half of Block "A"; the Northerly half of Block "B"; all of Blocks "C", "D", "E", and "F"; and all streets contained therein of Johnson Addition to Kevil, Kentucky as recorded in Plat Book "B", Page 43 of the Ballard County Court Clerk's Office, Ballard County, Kentucky and more particularly bounded and described as follows to wit:

Beginning at a point in the West line of Johnson Addition to Kevil, Kentucky as recorded in Plat Book "B", Page 43 of the Ballard County Court Clerk's Office at its intersection with the City Limits of Kevil, said point being 150 feet North of the North right-of-way line of U. S. Highway 60 and 350 feet West of the West right-of-way line of Johnson Drive; THENCE FROM SAID POINT OF BEGINNING N 15° 30' E with the West line of aforesaid Johnson Addition approximately 811 feet to the Northwest corner thereof; thence S 74° 10' E with the North line of said Johnson Addition approximately 775 feet to the Northeast corner thereof; thence S 15° 30' W with the East line of said Johnson Addition approximately 822 feet to a point in the aforesaid City Limits; thence N 75° W parallel with the North right-of-way line of U. S. Highway 60 and 150 feet Northwardly therefrom, approximately 775 feet to the point of beginning and containing approximately 14.5 acres.
