ORDINANCE NO. 1989-25

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KEVIL, KENTUCKY:

SECTION 1. The City has in Ordinance No. 89-25 declared its intent to annex 3.476 acres of land.

SECTION 2. All the residents therein have consented in writing to the annexation.

SECTION 3. The following described property be and is hereby annexed to and is now a part of the City of Kevil, Kentucky:

Being 3.476 acres just south of Kevil, Kentucky, and being more particularly described as follows: BEGINNING at the intersection of the east right-of-way line of Kentucky Highway 473 with the south right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 60; thence, with the east right-of-way line of Highway 473, S 03° 48' 40" E 527.25 ft. to an iron pin; thence, continuing with said east right-of-way line, S 04° 22' 07" E 229.09 ft. to an iron pin; thence, leaving said east right-of-way line of Highway 473, N 87° 48' 39" E 262.0 to an iron pin; thence, N 02° 53' 34" W 220.15 ft. to an iron pin; thence, S 89° 41' 11" W 88.37 ft. to an iron pin; thence, N 02° 43' W 470.57 ft. to a point in the south right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 60; thence, with the south right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 60 N 74° 02' 10" W 200.24 ft. to the point of beginning, containing 3.476 acres as determined by V. E. Newberry, Ky. L. S. 2844, on November 24, 1989.
