ORDINANCE NO. 6-93

ORDINANCE ANNEXING UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY
INTO THE CITY OF KEVIL, KENTUCKY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KEVIL, KENTUCKY:

(1) Pursuant to the request of the owners, the following described property being is hereby annexed into the corporate limits of the City of Kevil, Kentucky, towit:

Beginning at an iron rod located in the easterly margin of the Woodville-Kevil Road (KY. 473), said iron rod being the southwesterly corner of the property described herein; thence with said easterly margin North 21 deg. 17'22" East, 248.62 feet to an iron rod; thence North 22 deg. 21'22" East, 152.92 feet to an iron rod; thence South 67 deg. 38'38" East, 60.00 feet to an iron rod; thence North 22 deg. 21'22" East, 100.00 feet to an iron rod; thence North 67 deg. 38'38" West, 60.00 feet to an iron rod; thence North 22 deg. 21'22" East, 1119.98 feet to an iron rod, said iron rod being the northwesterly corner of the property described herein and also being the southwesterly corner of the Carl A. Greear property of record in Cabinet 1, Drawer 13, Card no. 26444, Ballard County Clerk's Office; thence leaving said easterly margin and with the southerly line Carl A. Greear South 67 deg. 48'24" East, 244.40 feet to an iron rod, said iron rod being the southwesterly corner of the Edward G. Throgmorton property of record in Cabinet 1, Drawer 6, Card no. 8249, Ballard County Clerk's Office; thence with said southerly line South 67 deg. 00'51" East, 798.35 feet to an iron rod, said iron rod being the southwesterly corner of the John Summers, ET UX and Kenneth Roettger, ET UX property of record in Deed Book 778, Page 26, Ballard County Clerk's Office; thence South 01 deg. 37'25" West, 52.24 feet to an iron rod; thence North 88 deg. 22'35" West, 66.05 feet to a point; thence South 01 deg. 37'25" West, 258.71 feet to an iron rod; thence North 88 deg. 22'35" West, 46.35 feet to an iron rod; thence South 02 deg. 36'24" West, 217.59 feet to an iron rod; thence North 87 deg. 23'36" West, 28.52 feet to a point; thence South 02 deg. 36'24" West, 328.54 feet to an iron rod; thence South 69 deg. 53'22" East, 51.05 feet to a point; thence South 20 deg. 06'38" West, 240.00 feet to an iron rod; thence North 69 deg. 53'22" West, 22.66 feet to an iron rod; thence South 20 deg. 06'38" West, 212.81 feet to an iron rod; thence North 69 deg. 53'22" West, 55.72 feet to a point; thence South 20 deg. 06'38" West, 258.71 feet to an iron rod located in the northerly line of the John K. Kelly property of record in Deed Book 56, Page 509, Ballard County Clerk's Office; thence with said northerly line North 69 deg. 53'22" West, 1202.23 feet to the point of beginning, containing 42.2672 acres.

Being a portion of the same property conveyed to John W. Summers and Linda G. Summers of record in Cabinet 1, Drawer 14, Card no. 28277, Ballard County Clerk's Office.

(2) The consent of the owners of record of land having been filed in writing with the city, this Ordinance shall become effective upon it's second reading and publication.
