ORDINANCE OF ANNEXATION

(Amending Ordinance 07-11-13-05)

WHEREAS, there has been a continual development of property in Kuttawa, Lyon County, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable and necessary for the consistent well-ordered growth of the City of Kuttawa, Kentucky, that the following described property be annexed and brought into the City of Kuttawa, to-wit:

TRACT I

A tract of land on the South side of Interstate Highway 24 East of U.S. Hwy. 62/641 in Lyon County, Kentucky, generally bounded on the West by lands of McKinney, the North by Interstate Highway 24, the East of lands formerly belonging to Waddle, and the South by lands of Crumbaugh, and is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a ½ inch steel concrete reinforcing bar (rebar)(set) in the Southerly right of way line of Interstate Highway 24, said rebar being 636.21 feet South of the Southernmost corner of Tract A along an extension of its Easterly boundary, said location being a common corner of the Parker Estate and Waddle property in the South right of way line of Interstate Highway 24; thence along a common boundary of Waddle and Parker Estate, South 00° 44'00" West, 758.39 feet to a 1/2 inch rebar (set) on the North side of the Old Smithland/Eddyville Road Southwest of a small cabin; thence generally along the Northerly right-of-way line of Smithland/Eddyville Road South 81° 38' 58" West, 158.16 feet to a ½ inch rebar (set) on the South side and at the base of a 24-inch Sweet Gum tree, generally following an existing fence line along a common fence boundary between Crumbaugh and the Parker Estate, South 86° 38' 58" West, 640.98 feet to a 1/2 inch rebar (set) at the base and on the South side of a 12-inch Sassafrass Tree, said location being a common corner of McKinney and Parker in Crumbaugh's line; thence along a common line between McKinney and Parker Estate due North 727.05 feet to a ½ inch rebar (set) in the South right of way line of Interstate Highway 24; thence along the South right of way line of Interstate Highway 24, North 83° 06' 53" East, 706.14 feet; thence continuing along the South line of Interstate Highway 24, North 86° 09' 29" East, 104.96 feet to a ½ inch rebar (set), the True Point of Beginning, containing 13.794 acres, and subject to legal highways and legal easements of record and in existence.

Attention is directed to the existence of a power line easement approximately 50 foot in width lying adjacent to and along the South side of the South right-of-way of Interstate Highway 24, crossing Tract B in the East-West direction.

EXCLUDED AND EXCEPTED from the above description is that portion of the proposed and relocated Mary Blue Road, more particularly described as follows:

A certain tract of land as surveyed by Kyrun Jett Wood, P.L.S.#3445 and being generally located along Mary Blue Road (a.k.a. Old Eddyville-Smithland Road). Lyon County, Kentucky, more particularly described as:

Beginning at a 1/2" diameter rebar & cap stamped "#1963" (found), said point being southwest corner of the Grady White Construction, Inc. and 3-D Coal, Inc. property (recorded in Deed Book 117, Page 246);

Thence with the above said property's south line S 83° 21' 23"E a distance of 20.17 ft. to a ½" diameter rebar & cap stamped "K.J.W. #3445" (set), said point being the true point of beginning;

Thence leaving the above said property line and being the new north right-of-way line of the proposed relocation of Mary Blue Road and being a curve to the left having a chord bearing of N 85° 45′ 56″E, a chord distance of 52.38 ft., a radius of 175.00 ft. and an arc distance of 52.58 ft. to a ½" diameter rebar & cap stamped "K.J.W. #3445" (set);

Thence continuing with the above said right-of-way line, also being a new line and being a curve to the right having a chord bearing of N 86° 24' 04"W, a chord distance of 80.02 ft., a radius of 225.00 ft. and an arc distance of 80.45 ft. to a ½" diameter rebar & cap stamped "K.J.W. #3445" (set);

Thence continuing with the above said right of way line and also being a new line S 83° 21' 23"E a distance of 248.79 ft. to a ½" diameter rebar & cap stamped "K.J.W. #3445" (set);

Thence continuing with the above said right-of-way line, also being a new line and being a curve to the left having a chord bearing of N 70° 59' 05"E, a chord distance of 43.30 ft., a radius of 50.00 ft. and an arc distance of 44.78 ft. to a ½" diameter rebar & cap stamped "K.J.W. #3445" (set);

Thence continuing with the above said right-of-way line, also being a new line and being a curve to the right having a chord bearing of S 64° 00' 38"E, a chord distance of 132.10 ft., a radius of 70.00 ft. and an arc distance of 172.66 ft. to a ½" diameter rebar & cap stamped "K.J.W. #3445" (set), said point also being located in the above said property's south property line;

Thence continuing with the above said property line N 83° 21' 23"W a distance of 542.47 ft. to the true point of beginning;

The above described Tract contains 0.3781 acres.

EXCEPTED ALSO HEREFROM is 3.800 acres conveyed to B & R Drennan Enterprises, Inc. by deed dated August 23, 2007 and recorded in Deed Book 145, page 766, Lyon County Court Clerk's Office.

This is a part of the same property conveyed to Grady White Construction, Inc. and 3-D Coal Inc. by deed from the Lyon County Master Commissioner, dated February 2, 1998 and recorded in Deed Book 117, page 246, Lyon County Court Clerk's Office.

TRACT II

A parcel of land located in Lyon County, KY, located at the southwest intersection of Interstate Highway 24 with US Highway 62 and described as follows:

All bearings herein stated are referenced to the west line of the Grady White Construction and 3D Coal, Inc. property (DB 117, Page 246).

Beginning at an iron pin in the south right of way of Interstate 24, said pin being the northwest corner of the Grady White Construction and 3D Coal, Inc. property (DB 117, Page 246) and being an iron pin bearing a cap marked L.S. #1963; thence with the north line of the Grady White Construction and 3D Coal, Inc. property N 88° 10' 31" E 352.54' to an iron pin, said iron pin being a new corner in the existing north line; thence with a new division line \$ 05° 03' 22" W 453.26' to an iron pin; thence with a new division line S 88° 10' 31" W 327,36' to an iron pin; thence with a new division line S 05° 03' 22" W 275.46' to an iron pin, said pin being in the south line of the Grady White Construction and 3D Coal, Inc. property (DB 117, Page 246); thence with an existing south line and with the Myrthel Johnson, Mildred Kivel, Elsworth Rice, Henry Clay Rice, Jr., James E. Rice, Ralph D. Rice, Tressa Edmondson, and Juanita Ford line (DB 56, Page 84) N 88° 16' 16" W 25.04' to an iron pin, said pin being the existing southwest corner of the Grady White Construction and 3D Coal, Inc. property (DB-117, Page 246) and being an iron pin bearing a cap marked L.S. #1963; thence with the existing west line of the Grady White Construction and 3D Coal, Inc. property (DB 117, Page 246) and with the Camp Oil Company (DB 124, Page 577) line N 05° 03' 22" E 727.16' to the beginning, containing 3.800 acres.

EXCEPTED from the 3.800 acres described above is that portion, if any, of the proposed and relocated Mary Blue Road, the description of which is set forth in the exception to Tract I above.

Thence, from said Point of Beginning and continuing with the east line of the Travel Center, N 06°24'01" E a distance of 248.86 feet to a found 1/2" iron rod and cap stamped "FRLS 3810", said point being the southwest corner of B&R Enterprises (Parcel II), as described in deed book 145, page 766; Thence, with the south line of Parcel II, N 89°31'10" E a distance of 352.54 feet to a 1/2" iron rod and cap stamped "FRLS 3810", said point being the southeast corner of Parcel II and also being in the west line of 3-D Coal Company and Grady White Construction (Parcel III), as described in deed book 117, page 246; Thence, with the west line of Parcel III, S 06°24'01" W a distance of 270.75 feet to a ½" iron rod and cap stamped "FRLS 3810", said point being the southwest corner of Parcel III; Thence, N 86°55'37" W a distance of 350.59 feet back to the Point of Beginning of the herein described tract.

Thence, from said Point of Beginning and continuing with the east line of the Travel Center, N 06°24'01" E a distance of 453.26 feet to a found 1/2" iron rod and cap stamped "Williams LS 1963", said point being on the south right of way line of the east bound on-ramp to Interstate 24; Thence, with said right of way, N 89°31'10" E a distance of 352.54 feet to a ½" iron rod and cap stamped "FRLS 3810" found at the northwest corner of 3-D Coal Company and Grady White Construction (Parcel III), as described in deed book 117, page 246; Thence, with the west line of Parcel III, S 06°24'01" W a distance of 453.26 feet to a 1/2" iron rod and cap stamped "FRLS 3810" found at the northeast corner of the above described Parcel I; Thence, with the north line of Parcel I, S 89°31'10" W a distance of 352.54 feet back to the Point of Beginning of the herein described tract.

Commencing at a ½" iron rod and cap stamped "FRLS 3810" found at the southeast corner of the Kuttawa Travel Center, as described in deed book 133, page 674; said point also being on the north line of a parcel conveyed to Lyon County, as described in deed book 146, page 559; Thence, from said Point of Commencement and along the east line of the Travel Center, N 06°24'01" E, passing the southwest corner of Parcel I at a distance of 25.04 feet, passing the southwest corner of Parcel II at a distance of 273.90 feet, continuing a total distance of 727.16 feet to a ½" iron rod and cap stamped "Williams LS 1963" found at the northwest corner of Parcel II, said point being on the south right of way line of the east bound on-ramp to Interstate 24; Thence, with said right of way, N 89°31'10" E a distance of 352.54 feet to a ½" iron rod and cap stamped "FRLS 3810" found at the northwest corner of 3-D Coal Company and Grady White Construction (Parcel III), as described in deed book 117, page 246, said point being the true Point of Beginning of the herein described tract; Thence, from

said Point of Beginning and continuing along said right of way line, N 89°31'10" E a distance of 353.60 feet to a 5/8" iron rod and cap stamped "CDG LS 3218"; Thence, continuing along said right of way line, S 87°25'24" E a distance of 105.02 feet to a 1/2" iron rod and cap stamped "Williams LS 1963" found at the northwest corner of the property conveyed to James and Toretha Rice, as described in deed book 80, page 293; Thence, along Rice's west line, S 07°08'22" W a distance of 758.46 feet to a 5/8" iron rod and cap stamped "CDG LS 3218" found on the north line of the property conveyed to Myrthel Johnson, et al., as described in deed book 62, page 93; Thence, along the north line of Johnson, S 87°54'36" W a distance of 152.14 feet to a 5/8" iron rod and cap stamped "CDG LS 3218" found at an angle break in said line; Thence, continuing along said line, N 86°57'36" W a distance of 83.87 feet to a point; Thence, with a non-tangential curve turning to the left, said curve having an arc length of 172.66 feet, having a radius of 70.00 feet, a chord bearing of N 67°42'19" W and a chord distance of 132.10 feet to a point; Thence, with a curve turning to the right, said curve having an arc length of 44.78 feet, having a radius of 49.90 feet, a chord bearing of S 67°18'50" W and a chord distance of 43.29 feet to a point; Thence, N 86°55'37" W a distance of 47.05 feet to a ½" iron rod and cap stamped "FRLS 3810" found at the southwest corner of Parcel I; Thence, N 06°24'01" E, passing the southeast corner of Parcel II at a distance of 270.75 feet, continuing a total distance of 724.01 feet back to the Point of Beginning of the herein described tract.

The above described parcel contains 7.65 acres more or less as surveyed under the supervision of Jacob C. Selph, Kentucky Professional Land Surveyor No. 3810, of Four Rivers Engineering & Surveying between April 30th, 2008 and March 20th, 2009. The above described property is a part same property conveyed to 3-D Coal Company and Grady White Construction, as described in deed book 117, page 246 of the records of Lyon County, Kentucky County Clerk's Office.

All bearings referred to are based on magnetic north as observed on April 30th, 2008. All iron pins referred to as set in the above description are 18" long ½" ribbed steel rebar with a 1" plastic cap marked "FRLS LS 3810".

WHEREAS, said property sought to be annexed is contiguous to the City's boundaries and is urban in character by reason of its proximity to the area of the City of Kuttawa, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, the city council of the City of Kuttawa, Kentucky, has established the zoning of the property annexed herein as a Service District, as set forth in Section 152.33 of the zoning ordinance of the City of Kuttawa, and

WHEREAS, the owners of record of said land have given prior written consent to the annexation of said property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KUTTAWA, KENTUCKY, in accordance with KRS 81A.410, that the hereinabove described property is hereby annexed by the City of Kuttawa, Kentucky.

This ordinance shall become effective upon the publication and passage in accordance to law.




