AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED  
TERRITORY AS A PART OF THE CITY OF LA CENTER,  
BALLARD COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of LaCenter,  
did on the 16 day of November, 1982, at a meeting,  
adopt an Ordinance entitled "Proposing The Annexation Of  
Certain Unincorporated Territory As A Part Of The City Of  
LaCenter, Kentucky , and

WHEREAS, said proposed ordinance has been duly and  
regularly published in four consecutive issues of the Advance  
Yeoman, a weekly newspaper published in Wickliffe, Kentucky,  
beginning with the issue of September 2, 1982, and

WHEREAS, thirty days have elapsed since the adoption and  
enactment of the ordinance, "Proposing the Annexation of  
Certain Unincorporated Territory as a Part of the City of  
LaCenter, Kentucky", and no resident or free holder of the  
territory therein described as filed a petition in the Ballard  
Circuit Court, as provided by the Revised Statutes, making  
complaint as to the annexation of said territory as a part of  
the corporate limits of said City,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA CENTER,  
KENTUCKY, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the territory hereinbelow described,  
being in the general area of Hinkleville Road and South of  
U.S.Highway #60, and lying adjacent to the City Limits of  
the City of LaCenter, Kentucky, be annexed and taken into  
the corporate limits of the City of LaCenter, Kentucky, which  
territory is described by metes and bounds, as follows:

Lying along Hinkleville Road (Kentucky Highway 358) and being Southeast of the present City Limits of LaCenter, Ballard County, Kentucky, and more particularly bounded and described as follows, to wit:


Beginning at a point in the center of Hinkleville Road (Kentucky Highway 358) at its intersection with the South-easterly line of the present City Limits of LaCenter, Ballard County, Kentucky; THENCE FROM SAID POINT OF BEGINNING N 37° 00' E with the Southeasterly line of said present City Limits approximately 185 feet to a point; thence S 53° 00' E parallel with the centerline of said Hinkleville Road approximately 927 feet to a point; thence S 37° 00' W and crossing the centerline of aforesaid Hinkleville Road at approximately 185 feet for a total distance of approximately 350 feet to a point; thence N 53° 00' W parallel with the centerline of said Hinkleville Road approximately 927 feet to a point in the Southeasterly line of aforesaid present City Limits of the City of La Center, Kentucky; thence N 37° 00' E with said Southeasterly line approximately 165 feet to the point of beginning and containing approximately 7.45 acres, according to a Plat and Survey made by Rod H. Martin, Kentucky Land Surveyor, on the 15th day of June, 1982.

SECTION 2: The above described territory from and after the date of enactment of this Ordinance shall be considered a part of the Corporate Limits of the City of LaCenter, Kentucky.


SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption and publication in one issue of the Advance-Yeoman, of Wickliffe, Kentucky, a newspaper of general circulation in Ballard County Kentucky.
