ORDINANCE NO. 55

ORDINANCE ANNEXING UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY INTO THE CITY OF LaCENTER

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LaCENTER:

(1) Pursuant to the request of the owners, the following described property being is hereby annexed into the corporate limits of the City of LaCenter, Kentucky, towit:

Beginning at a point in the centerline of Kentucky Highway No. 802 and being approximately 0.6 miles South of U.S. Highway No. 60; thence South 4 deg. 00 Min. West with the centerline of Kentucky Highway 802 for 248 feet to a point; thence North 86 deg. 00 Min. West for 235.2 feet to a stake; thence North 4 deg. 00 Min. East for 168.95 feet to a post; thence North 4 deg. 00 Min. East for 79.2 feet to a corner post; thence South 86 deg. 00 Min. East for 235.2 feet to the point of beginning, and containing a gross area of 1.34 acres, less highway right of way area of 0.17 acres, giving a net area of 1.17 acres, as shown by Survey made my J. K. Kelly, Surveyor No. 1378, on July 26, 1982.

Being in all respects a part of the same property to which Roy M. Bondurant and wife, Vicki Bondurant derived title by Deed dated July 30, 1982 from Gordon R. Bondurant and wife, Mary Bondurant of record in Cabinet 1, Drawer 9, Card 14384, Ballard County Court Clerk's Office

(2) The consent of the owners of record of land having been filed in writing with the city, this Ordinance shall become effective upon it's second reading and publication.

(3) Enacted at it's first reading on September 8, 1992 and at it's second reading on October 13, 1992.
