ORDINANCE NO. 63

"AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED ~~TERRITORY~~ K. Adkins
INTO THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LACENTER, KENTUCKY."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LACENTER, KENTUCKY:

SECTION 1.

Pursuant to the consent of and request of the owners thereof there is hereby annexed into the City of LaCenter, Kentucky, the following described tract or parcel of land:

A parcel of land forming a portion of the Illinois Central Gulf Railroad Company's 100 foot wide abandoned East Cairo District right-of-way situated at LaCenter, Ballard County, Kentucky, said right-of-way being more particularly described as follows: From the point where a line that lies parallel with and 100 feet normally distant northerly from the centerline of the Illinois Central Gulf Railroad company's East Cairo District main track as now or formerly located, intersects in the centerline of 60 foot wide Olive Street, run westerly along said parallel line 635 feet, more or less, to the northwest corner of a parcel of land acquired by said former Railroad Company from M. M. Davis by deed dated September 4, 1902, (recorded in Deed Book 16 on Page 400); thence Northwesterly along the east line of a parcel of land acquired by said former Railroad Company from R. Cotner, et al., by deed dated October 20, 1902, (recorded in Deed Book 16 on Page 429), 60 feet, more or less, to the northeast corner thereof, said corner lying in a line that lies parallel with and 150 feet normally distant Northerly from the centerline of said main track; thence Westerly along said parallel line, being along the north line of said former Cotner, et al., property, 1000 feet to the northwest corner thereof; thence Southeasterly along the west line of said Cotner property, 115 feet, more or less, to a point 50 feet perpendicularly distant northerly from the centerline of said main track, being the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence Southerly perpendicular to the centerline of said main track, 100 feet to Grantor's south right-of-way line; thence Westerly at a right angle to the last described course, being along said south right-of-way line, 300 feet; thence Northerly at a right angle to the last described course, 100 feet; thence Easterly 300 feet to return to the point of beginning.

Executed at its first reading on October 11, 1994, and at its second reading on NOVEMBER 8, 1994.
