AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ANNEXATION OF LAND OR TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, KENTUCKY

2006-11

WHEREAS, certain lands lying North of Kentucky 44 and East of the U. S. 127 Bypass and adjacent to the existing boundaries of the City of Lawrenceburg, are suitable for development for urban and governmental purposes without unreasonable delay, and are not within the boundary of another incorporated city,

WHEREAS, it is desirable for the City of Lawrenceburg to annex the unincorporated territory;

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of Anderson County, Kentucky, is the owner of certain real property west of the city limits of the City of Lawrenceburg north of Kentucky 44 and east of U. S. 127 Bypass and more particularly described in a deed dated January 5, 2004, and of record in the office of the Clerk of the Anderson County Court in Deed Book 208, Page 744;

WHEREAS, on May 25, 2006, the Board of Education of Anderson County, Kentucky, by and through Sandra Whitaker, its chairman, executed a Consent to Annex pursuant to KRS 81A.412, *et seq.*, agreeing to the annexation of said property by the City of Lawrenceburg;

WHEREAS, Jo Anne Perry and Arnold C. Perry, wife and husband, are the owners of certain real property west of the city limits of the City of Lawrenceburg north of Kentucky 44 and east of U. S. 127 Bypass and more particularly described in a deed dated August 15, 2005, and of record in office of the Clerk of the Anderson County Court in Deed Book 220, Page 453;

WHEREAS, on May 22, 2006, Jo Anne Perry and Arnold C. Perry, wife and husband, executed a Consent to Annex pursuant to KRS 81A.412, *et seq.*, agreeing to the annexation of a portion of said property by the City of Lawrenceburg;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Council of the City of Lawrenceburg, convened in session on the 10th day of July, 2006, as follows:


