



ORDINANCE  
RELATING TO THE ANNEXATION OF LAND OR TERRITORY  
TO THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, KENTUCKY

1984 - 6

WHEREAS, an Ordinance declaring the intent to annex the hereinafter described property was duly enacted by the Board of Council of the City of Lawrenceburg, on the 2nd day of April, 1984; and

WHEREAS, a true and exact copy of said Ordinance was published in the April 26th, 1984, edition of The Anderson News, which Ordinance gave notice pursuant to KRS 81A.420 of the intent of said Council to enact an Ordinance annexing the subject real estate into the City of Lawrenceburg; and

WHEREAS, the owner of said property desires the annexation and whereas it is the finding of the Board of Council that such annexation will be desirable and that such annexation will be beneficial to the City of Lawrenceburg; and

WHEREAS, following the publication of the Ordinance declaring the intent to annex the hereinafter described property, no valid petition has been received by the Mayor, as set out in KRS 81A.420.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, convened in regular session on the 6th day of August, 1984, as follows:

(1) That pursuant to KRS 81A.420 and all other applicable law, the territory hereinafter described shall be, and is hereby, a part of the City of Lawrenceburg, Kentucky and is annexed into the City of Lawrenceburg, Kentucky, said property this day annexed, being the tract of real estate, lying and being at the end of Peach Drive, in the City of Lawrenceburg, Kentucky, and more fully bounded and described as follows:

**Exhibit "C"**

Being a tract of land in Anderson County, Kentucky, located on the end of Peach Drive, and being on the North West corner of the property owned by Jesse Ray Carlton, of Lawrenceburg, Anderson County, Kentucky, and consisting of three (3) acres and being 361.5 X 361.5.

(2) That the Mayor of the City of Lawrenceburg shall cause an accurate map of the annexed area, together with a metes and bounds description, together with a true and correct copy of this Ordinance, duly certified, to be recorded in the Office of the Clerk of the Anderson County Court, and in the Office of the Secretary of State for the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

(3) That the Mayor of the City of Lawrenceburg shall cause a map, clearly delineating the boundaries of the area affected, along with a list of the names and addresses of those property owners, and/or registered voters, if any, who reside in such area, to be filed in the Office of the Clerk of the Anderson County Court. The Mayor of the City of Lawrenceburg is further authorized and directed to cause the advertisement and publication of this Ordinance, pursuant to law, in The Anderson News, a newspaper of general publication within the area to be annexed.

PASSED AND APPROVED, by the Board of Council of the City of Lawrenceburg, on this the 6th day of August, 1984, with yea and nay votes of the Board of Council, as follows:
