ORDINANCE NO. 96- 2

FINAL ORDINANCE ANNEXING AREA  
TO CITY OF LOUISA, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, Ollie Tackett, widow, and Mark Alley, single, consented to the annexation of the hereinafter described property as shown by the attached letter of June 5, 1996; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to KRS 81A.412 the City may proceed with the enactment of a final ordinance annexing the hereinafter described area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Louisa, Kentucky deems it desirable to annex the hereinafter described unincorporated territory; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City of Louisa, Kentucky to annex the hereinafter described unincorporated territory;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LOUISA, KENTUCKY, that all the lands within the hereinafter described boundary of land be and they are hereby annexed to and are now a part of the City of Louisa, Kentucky, to-wit:


Beginning at a point in the U.S. Highway Right of Way, Joe A. Young and Lester Alley lines; thence N 45 E, approximately 500 feet to the corner of Kevin Gauze, Lester Alley and Joe A. Young; thence N 45 E, 770 feet with Kennis Gauze and Lester Alley line to the corner of Kennis Gauze, Lester Alley, Hobert Perry and Jay Frazier Farm; thence, N 28 W, 212 feet to a pine tree above the grave yard; thence down the hill N 11 W, 335 feet to a sycamore in a drain; thence N 44 E, approximately 120 feet to the C & O Railroad Right of Way; thence N 56.05 W, approximately 550 feet with the Railroad to Two-Mile Creek

and the line of Ollie Tackett Farm; thence N 63.03 W, approximately 1150 feet to a point in the C & O Railroad Right of Way, U.S. 23 Highway Right of Way and Ollie Tackett Farm; thence with the U.S. 23 Highway Right of Way S 48.53.48 E, 511.34 feet; S 25.11.24 E, 207.30 feet; S 30.00.57 E, 316.22 feet; S 15.47.57 E, 188.58; S 08.38.14 W, 263.82 feet; S 42.55.52 W, 110.58 feet; S 08.16.31 E, 405.01 feet; S 39.23.58 E, 76.10 feet; S 04.46.13 W, 375.45 feet to the point of beginning.

A map of the proposed area of annexation is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after its publication as required by law.
