FINAL ORDINANCE DEFINING  
AREA TO BE ANNEXED

WHEREAS, the City of Louisa, Kentucky deems it desirable to annex the hereinafter described unincorporated territory; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City of Louisa, Kentucky to annex the hereinafter described unincorporated territory; and

WHEREAS, the owners of the real property within the limits of the territory to be annexed have filed a petition with the Mayor of the City of Louisa requesting said annexation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LOUISA, KENTUCKY, that the corporate limits of the City of Louisa, Kentucky as now established be now extended so as to include the hereinafter described territory and to annex the same to the City of Louisa, Kentucky, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point near The Big Sandy River and on the North line of the Sewage Plant property, which has recently been annexed into the City Limits; Thence up the bank in a South direction to the West side of the C & O Railroad tracks; Thence in a Northwesterly direction with the C & O Railroad tracks to a point just East of the Old U. S. 23 Road curve; Thence leaving the Railroad and with the Old 23 Road, to the right-of-way line of the First by Pass Road at Elmer Crabtree property; Thence Northwest with Highway line to the property of Joe A. Young line, to include this property to the West right-of-way line of the New U. S. 23 By Pass; Thence South with the New By Pass to a point in line with Kathryn Maynard's property; Thence in a Northeasterly direction to the Old By Pass right-of-way; Thence in a Northeasterly direction to the Old By Pass right-of-way; Thence leaving Maynard line and with the West right-of-way line of the Old by Pass line to the property of Frederick and Frederick property line, formerly known as the Fulkerson Hollow; Thence leaving the Highway and up with the center of the ridge and Maynard line in a Southwest direction to the right-of-way line of the New 23 By Pass right-of-way; Thence South with the right-of-way to the line of Ire Pigg at the center point of ridge; Thence East along the ridge with Pigg and Frederick to the Pine Hill Cemetery line and present City Limits; Thence East along the Cemetery Road to the line of the P. H. Vaughn property at the Water Tank just West of the Vaughn Cemetery; Thence leaving the Cemetery Road and North, to include the Water Tank; Thence North along the line of the P. H. Vaughn property down the hill to the West line of the Old By Pass right-of-way next to Jay Lynn See; Thence East along the West line of the By Pass right-of-way to the City Limits; Thence crossing the By Pass and down the hill with the City Limits to Lackey Avenue;

Thence Westerly with Lackey Avenue to Old 23 or now Highway 3;  
Thence East along Highway 3 to a point above The Salt Branch  
crossing at the City Limits line; Thence North leaving the  
Highway crossing the Railroad down Salt Branch to the  
beginning.

A map of the proposed area of annexation is attached hereto  
and made a part hereof.

This Ordinance shall be of full force and effect after the adopting  
of the City Council.
