
Dear Libby:

WHEREAS, KRS 81A.530 provides a means whereby a city of the sixth class may seek annexation and be annexed by an adjoining city of the third, fourth or fifth class, and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Whipps Millgate has adopted an ordinance in accordance with KRS 81A.530 to authorize a petition by its registered voters to be annexed to the City of Lyndon, and

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Clerk, through the Jefferson County Board of Elections has certified the petition as containing the signatures of more than fifty-one percent (51%) of the number of registered voters in the City of Whipps Millgate, and

WHEREAS, the certified petition has been presented to the City of Lyndon, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LYNDON:

1. The City Council of the City of Lyndon hereby determines that it has a common boundary with the City of Whipps Millgate, and that the entire area of the City of Whipps Millgate can be better served by the City of Lyndon and should be annexed by the City of Lyndon, and the City of Whipps Millgate dissolved as so approved in accordance with KRS 81A.530.
2. The annexation is hereby approved and the entire area of the City of Whipps Millgate is hereby annexed (merged) with the City of Lyndon, and in accordance with the ordinance adopted by the City of Keeneland:
 - a) All assets and liabilities of the City of Whipps Millgate shall pass to and become the assets and liabilities of the City of Lyndon;
 - b) All taxes or revenues for the City of Whipps Millgate shall thereafter belong to the City of Lyndon;
 - c) The zoning classification on all land within the City of Whipps Millgate shall remain unchanged until changed by the City of Lyndon in accordance with KRS Chapter 100;
 - d) The annexation shall become effective as of 7/1/01.
3. The City of Whipps Millgate shall be dissolved effective with the effective date of this ordinance.



Any indebtedness for which Whipps Millgate is liable on the date of annexation shall be assumed by the City of Lyndon, so that after annexation the burden of taxation shall be uniform throughout the area of the two (2) cities, to one city.
5. This ordinance shall be come effective on July 1, 2001.

WHEREAS, the certified petition has been presented to the City of Lyndon, Kentucky.



The record of same shall be entered upon the records of said city and copies of said record may be certified by the City Clerk as needed.

3. The Clerk of this Court, no later than ten (10) days after this Judgment is entered herein, shall certify a copy of this Judgment to the Secretary of State of the Commonwealth of Kentucky whose duty it shall be to properly enter and file the same in the Office of the Secretary of State, Commonwealth of Kentucky.

AN ORDINANCE FINALLY DEANNEXING FROM
THE CITY OF WHIPPS MILLGATE, KENTUCKY,
A CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND NOW PART OF THE
CITY OF WHIPPS MILLGATE, KENTUCKY, COM-
MONLY KNOWN AS MEADOWGATE SUBDIVISION,
SECTIONS 1 AND 2, LOCATED GENERALLY IN THE
NORTHEAST PORTION OF THE CITY OF WHIPPS
MILLGATE, KENTUCKY, A DETAILED DESCRIP-

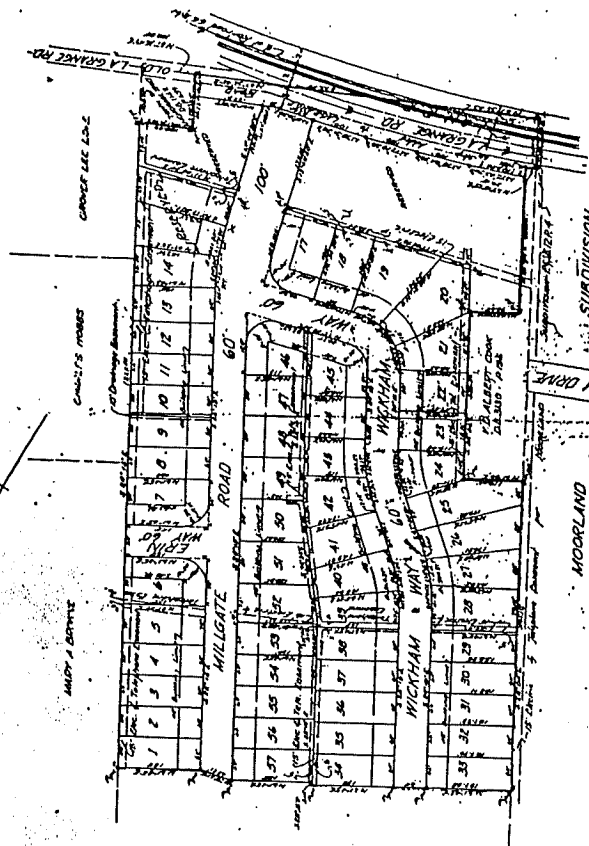

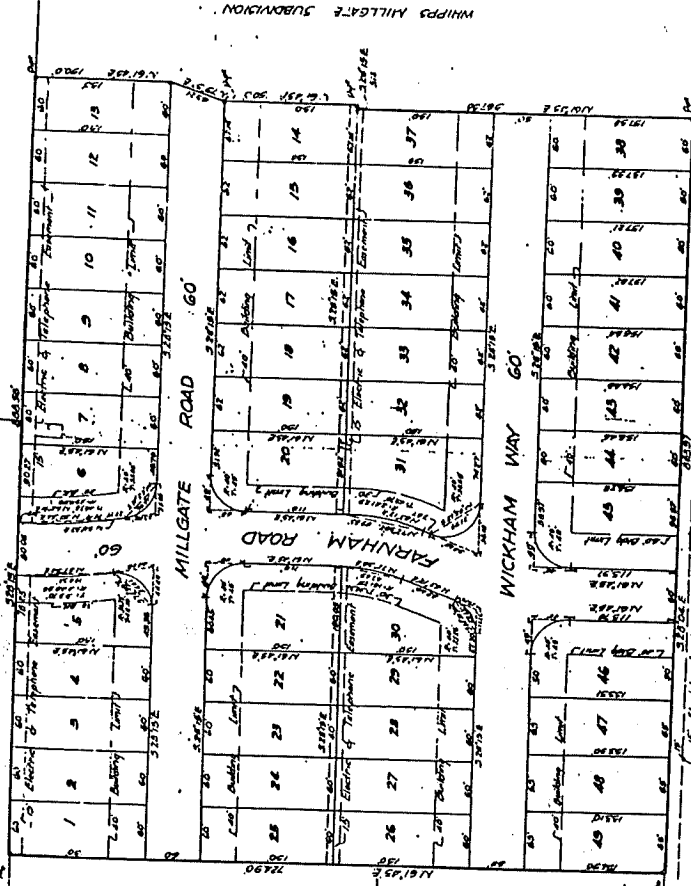
