



AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MADISONVILLE,  
ANNEXING TO THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF  
MADISONVILLE, KENTUCKY A CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND  
ADJACENT TO AND CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY OF MADISONVILLE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF MADISONVILLE, KENTUCKY:

WHEREAS, the City of Madisonville has deemed it desirable and has proposed to annex to the City of Madisonville, Kentucky, and extend the boundaries of the City of Madisonville, Kentucky, to include a certain tract of land which is adjacent to and contiguous with the present City boundary and which by population density is urban in character and suitable for urban purposes without unreasonable delay and;

WHEREAS, on the 1st day of April, 1985, an Ordinance proposing to annex the hereinafter described tract of land was given first reading by the Madisonville City Council and on the 15th day of April, 1985, the Ordinance proposing to annex said tract of land was given a second reading and adopted by the Madisonville City Council and was published pursuant to law, and there was no petition in opposition filed with the Mayor of the City of Madisonville from the resident voters or owners of real property within the limits of the territory proposed to be annexed. More than sixty (60) days have elapsed since the adoption and enactment of the original Ordinance seeking to annex said territory;

Section I. Therefore, the City of Madisonville hereby annexes by Ordinance to the City territory and extends its boundaries to include a certain tract of land hereinafter described and upon passage of this Ordinance the territory shall become a part of the City of Madisonville, Kentucky, for all purposes henceforth.

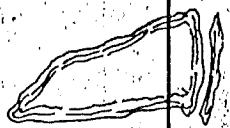
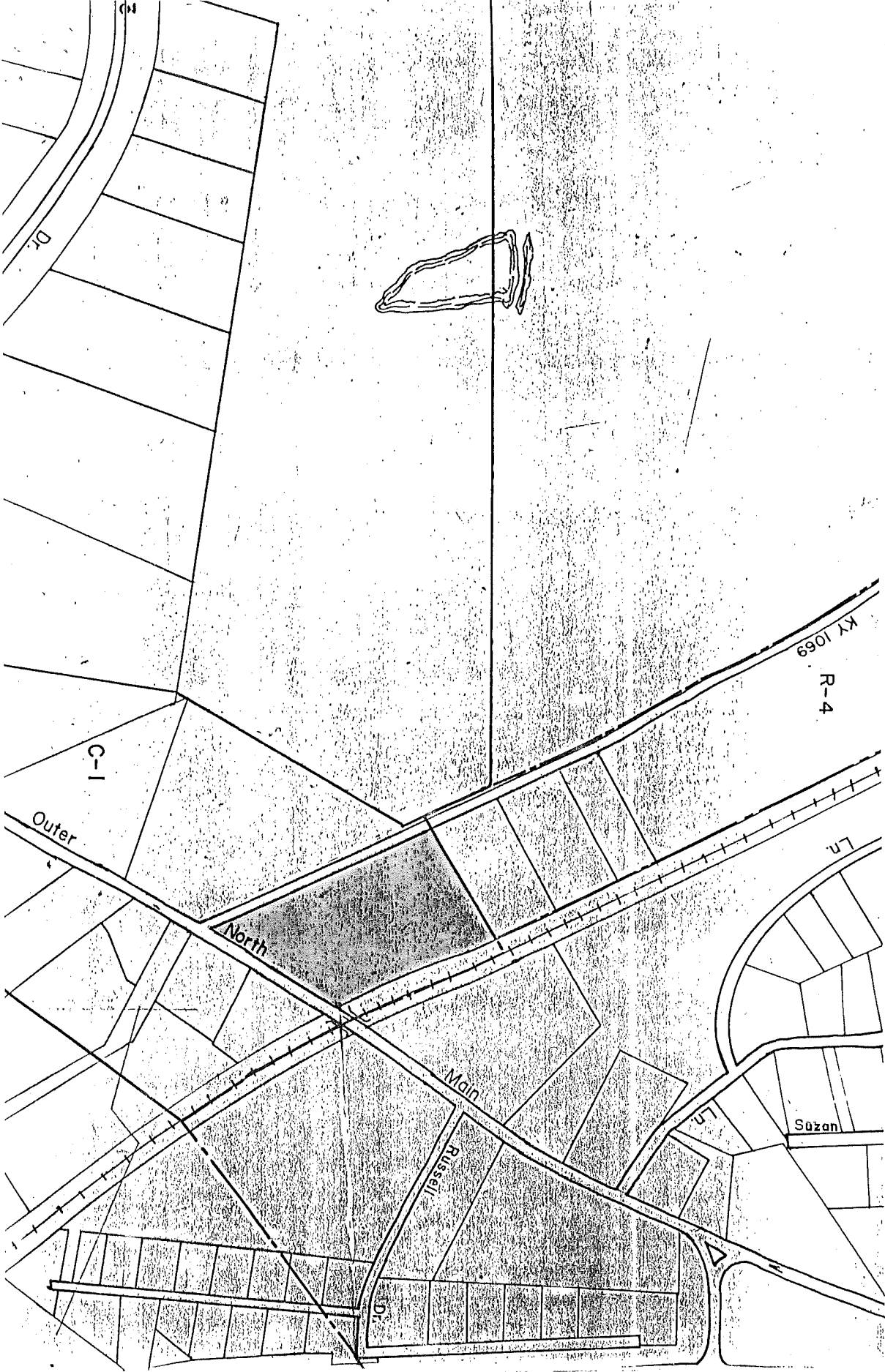
Section II. A particular description of the tract of land annexed is as follows:

Beginning at a point at intersection of right of way line of Ky. 1751 highway and the right of way of the L & N Railroad, running thence along the L & N Railroad

right of way N 25 degrees W 431 feet to the line of H. C. Kercheval, Jr., property; thence along Kercheval's line S. 57-1/2 degrees W. approximately 251 feet to right of way line of old Hanson road; thence along this right of way line S. 24 degrees E. 560 feet, more or less, to a concrete marker in the right of way line of KY Hwy. 1751; thence easterly along this right of way line 55-1/2 feet; thence southerly along this right of way line 30 feet to another point in this right of way; thence along this right of way easterly about 244.9 feet to a point of beginning; being a plot bounded on one side by L & N Railroad, on one side by Kercheval and the other sides along old Hanson Road and new Hanson Road, and containing 3.2 acres, more or less.

Being the same property conveyed to Oscar Ramsey and his wife, Gayle Ramsey by deed from Corum and Edwards, Inc., dated February 15, 1985, and of record in Deed Book 446, page 527, Hopkins County Court Clerk's Office.

Section III. The City Clerk is authorized and directed to immediately publish this Ordinance pursuant to KRS Chapter 424 and this Ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage, signing and upon publication as required by law.
