JUDGMENT

This action coming on to be heard, and it appearing to the Court from the record herein, that due notice of the filing of the Petition herein and the object thereof has been published in two issues of the Louisville Times, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in Louisville, Jefferson County, Kentucky, on January 18th, 1963 and January 25th, 1963; and it further appearing to the Court, and the Court being sufficiently advised on the verified petition herein, that the population within the boundary described in said petition is sufficient to meet the requirements of law in such cases, and no defense having been interposed, herein, it is now

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

1. That a city known as "MARYHILL ESTATES" be, and the same is hereby established as a municipal corporation of the sixth class, within the following described boundary, as shown by the map filed with the petition herein, and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at the southwest corner of Maryhill Estates and an unnamed road as set out in plat of said Subdivision recorded in Plat and Subdivision Book 17, Page 84, Jefferson County Court Clerk's Office, Kentucky; running thence in a Northerly direction 758.79 feet to the North line of a thirty foot roadway; thence in an Easterly direction along the North line of the said Maryhill Estates Subdivision 1052.64 feet to an iron pipe; thence in a Southerly direction along the Easterly boundary of Maryhill Estates Subdivision, 1009.43 feet; thence in a Westerly direction 1097.60 feet to the point of beginning.

As more particularly described in Plat and Subdivision Book 17, Page 84, in the Clerk's office aforesaid.


2. That there are hereby appointed as a Board of Trustees

of the said City of Maryhill Estates, the following named persons, residents therein.



As Police Judge thereof, Lee Perme; as Marshal thereof, A.J. Osborne; and as Assesson there of, Joan Hammer. Each of the Trustees and officers shall hold their respective offices until the next election at which officers for city and towns may be elected. The qualification of said officers shall be in the manner provided by law, by taking the necessary oaths of office and executing respective bonds and obligations as may be prescribed by law, a record of which shall be entered upon the records of said City, and copies thereof certified.

3. It is further ordered by the Court that the Clerk of this Court, not later than ten (10) days from the entry of this judgment, send a certified copy thereof to the Secretary of State for the purpose of properly indexing and filing same as a permanent record in his office.
