ORDINANCE NO. 0 - 96 - 03

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE CITY OF MELBOURNE
TO ANNEX CERTAIN PORTIONS OF
UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS: It has been determined that the City of Melbourne is desirous of incorporating within its boundaries certain unincorporated portions of Campbell County which borders the City of Melbourne, and which is described as set out below; therefore,

WHEREAS: The owners of the below described property have requested this land be annexed into the City of Melbourne,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF MELBOURNE, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY, that said City does hereby annex as part of the City of Melbourne, Campbell County, Kentucky, the unincorporated territory described as follows:

Being situated in Campbell County, Kentucky, lying along the north side of State Route 8 and the east boundary of the Town of Melbourne, and being more particularly described: Beginning at an iron pin set in the north 30' right-of-way for State Route 8 and in the original Greis east line; Thence along right-of-way N. 84 degrees 02' 52" W 129.45' to an iron pin set; Thence N. 85 degrees 20' 41" W. 158.67' to the center of a private roadway; Thence continuing along State Route 8 N. 85 degrees 20' 41" W. 145.74' to an iron pin set corner to St. Phillips Catholic Church; Thence along the church property N. 27 degrees 46' 00" E. 415.70' to an iron pin set; Thence N. 32 degrees 18' 43" W. 201.45 to an iron pin set; Thence N. 32 degrees 18' 43" W. 9.84' to an iron pin set; Thence N. 3 degrees 33' 04" W. 47.95' to an iron pin set; Thence N. 70 degrees 01' 15" W. 202.13' to an iron pin set in the original west line of Greis and the east line of the Town of Melbourne; Thence along same N.29 degrees 00' 00" E. 331.96' to an iron pin set at a post found, being the south right of way line for the CSX Railroad; Thence S. 77 degrees 58' 53" E. 853.31' to an iron pin set; Thence along the east line of the original Greis tract S. 29 degrees 00' 00" W. 930.76' to the point of beginning. 
