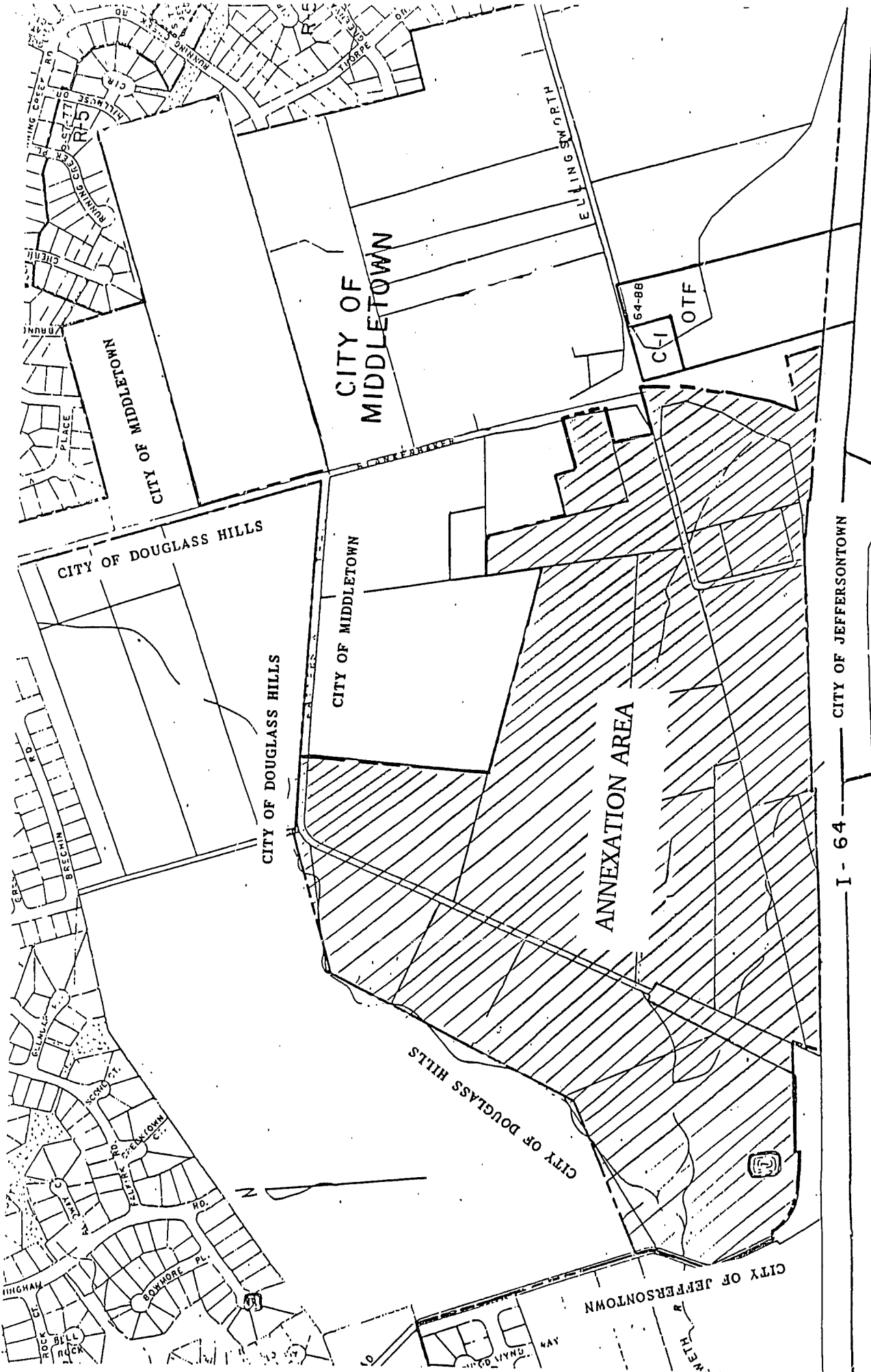

ORDINANCE NO. 97-12

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF MIDDLETOWN A CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND IN THE COUNTY OF JEFFERSON, ADJOINING THE PRESENT CITY OF MIDDLETOWN AND BEING ADJACENT TO AND CONTIGUOUS WITH THE PRESENT SOUTHWESTERLY BOUNDARY OF SAID CITY AND MORE PARTICULARLY HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED AS CONTAINED IN PROPOSED ORDINANCE 93-06 AND 97-01.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 93-06 and Ordinance 97-01, the City proposed to annex the tract hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid ordinance was published as required by KRS 424, together with the notices required by KRS Chapters 81A and 424, and

WHEREAS, the final day for the filing of a petition with the Mayor was August 18, 1997, and no petition having been received by the Mayor, and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that this annexation meets all legal qualifications and is in the best interest of the City, now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF MIDDLETOWN:

Section 1. There is hereby annexed to the City of Middletown, Kentucky, and the boundary is hereby extended so as to include within the boundaries of the City of Middletown, certain tract of land which was formerly embraced within the County of Jefferson, and which is adjacent to and contiguous with the present city boundary line and more particularly described as follows:

BEING a tract of land lying in Jefferson County, Kentucky, and bounded on the South by I-64 and the boundary of the City of Jeffersontown, bounded on the West by the boundary of the City of Jeffersontown and the City of Douglass Hills, bounded on the North by the boundary of the City of Douglass Hills, Watterson Trail, and the exiting boundary of the City of Middletown, and bounded on the East by the existing boundary of the City of Middletown and Blankenbaker Road (sometimes referred to as Blankenbaker Lane) and including the full width of that portion of any roadway or public easement immediately adjacent to the tract herein described; provided, however, there is excluded from the

foregoing description so much of the tract above described as legally lies within City of Douglass Hills or City of Jeffersontown.

A map is attached hereto showing the area in hatched marks, provided that where there is any conflict between the hatched area and the area above described, the greater area of existing unincorporated area shall control.

Section 2. Until changed as provided by law, the property herein described shall bear same zoning classification as it currently enjoys in the County of Jefferson.

Section 3. All ordinances heretofore duly adopted and in force in the present City of Middletown shall equally apply to the area described in this ordinance.

Section 4. Immediately upon the passage hereof, the City Clerk is authorized and directed to publish this ordinance pursuant to KRS Chapter 424 and said ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its enactment and publication.
