
County Clerk:

AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING ANNEXATION OF UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY ADJOINING THE CITY OF MT. WASHINGTON, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY.


BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Mt. Washington, Bullitt County, as follows:

Washington, Bullitt County, Kentucky, as such territory shall become a part of the Commonwealth of Kentucky; and further, such territory annexed is described as follows:



Following is real estate located on State Highway No. 44 near Mt. Washington in Bullitt County, Kentucky:


First Tract: Beginning at a black walnut tree in line of Wm. Clark, and running thence with his line South  $53 \frac{1}{4}$  East 12.57 chains to a stone, corner to 12 acre tract of James V. McAfee; thence with line of same, excluding it, South  $57 \frac{3}{4}$  West  $12 \frac{3}{5}$  chains to stone, corner to said tract; thence South 45 East 10.16 chains to stone, corner to said tract in above highway; thence with line of said highway South 51 West 3.65 chains. South  $46 \frac{3}{4}$  West 7.28 chains; South  $54 \frac{3}{4}$  West 2.42 chains to stone, corner to Clarence Porter; thence with his line North  $36 \frac{3}{4}$  West 17.87 chains to stone and North  $61 \frac{1}{2}$  West 38.53 chains to stone corner to Porter and Owens; thence with Owens North  $23 \frac{3}{4}$  East 17.06 chains to a white oak, corner to Clark; thence with Clark South  $65 \frac{3}{4}$  East 45.00 chains to the beginning, containing 111.80 acres according to survey made by Curtis Ochs on March 30, 1935.

Second Tract: Beginning with a stone in division line of fence between J. V. McAfee, and W. F. Clark on west side of the Mt. Washington - Shepherdsville Road and running in a southwest direction to a stone in the line between Dr. Schneider (now one of tracts being conveyed by this deed) and McAfee; thence with Schneider's line division lien between Schneider and McAfee, back to Clark's line; thence with Clark and McAfee's line back to the beginning, containing  $12 \frac{1}{2}$  acres, more or less, and bounded on the north by W. F. Clark, on west and south by Dr. Schneider, and on the east by the Shepherdsville - Mt. Washington Road.

Third Tract: Adjoining the lands of Joseph N. Owen (now Alonzo Wyatt) on the north; McFarland heirs (now Mathis) on the east; J. Hardin Hall (now Dr. Henry Schneider) on the south and a public road on the west supposed to contain 47 acres, more or less.

This is subject to legal highways and easement of Salt River Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation.

BEING the same property conveyed to Harry F. Roggenkamp and his wife, Ardelia Roddenkamp by Cave Snider, et. al., by deed dated May 23, 1931, recorded in Deed Book 78, Page 40, in the office of the County Court Clerk of Bullitt County, Kentucky.
