AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING ANNEXATION OF UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY ADJOINING THE CITY OF MT. WASHINGTON, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Mt. Washington, Bullitt County, Kentucky, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The City Council of the City of Mt. Washington, Bullitt County, Kentucky, does hereby ordain that it confirms the annexation of certain unincorporated territory to the City of Mt. Washington, Bullitt County, Kentucky, and such territory shall become a part of the City for all purposes under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky; and further, such territory annexed is described as follows:

First Tract

BEGINNING at the Northeasterly corner at the Mt. Washington Cemetery at Mt. Washington on the Southerly side of Kentucky Highway No. 44 between Mt. Washington and Taylorsville and running thence with the South line of said Highway 44, 360 feet in an Easterly direction to an agreed corner to remaining land of Leon and Edith Grigsby and 5 feet South of said agreed corner is located a steel pin on the agreed division line and running thence in a Southerly direction with an agreed line 695 feet to a steel pin located on the Northerly side of an old road running along Northerly side of land of Shelly Stump and thence in a Westerly direction 400 feet to a point, where some trees stand few feet North of said old road; thence dropping to a point in center of said old road and continuing with the center line of said old road as said road runs 1069 feet to a line post, corner to Hillcrest Subdivision and then crossing to the Easterly side of the road at Hillcrest Subdivision and running with said Subdivision Easterly line of the Road 105 feet to the Southwesterly corner of the cemetery; thence with line of said cemetery in a Northeasterly direction 895 feet to the Southeasterly corner of the cemetery and thence with Eastern line of same 100 feet to the beginning and containing approximately 16 acres, more or less, but conveyed as a boundary.

Second Tract

BEGINNING at a point in center of Hillcrest Avenue, at intersection of same with old County Road called Old Shelbyville Road in Deed and running thence with lines of Marion J. Porter and William F. Porter, South 77 East 1747 feet to a cedar tree; thence continuing with line of William F. Porter and J. H. Stout South 33 West 721 feet to elm tree, corner to Geo. Maddox; thence with his line South 14 degrees 30 minutes East

913 feet to a stone and South 77 degrees 15 minutes East 1377 feet to oak tree, corner to William Couch; thence with his line South 83 degrees 30 minutes East 705 feet to stone, corner to L. M. Wigginton; thence with his lines North 22 degrees 30 minutes, East 577 feet to fork of branch and North 2 degrees 30 minutes East 248 feet and North 64 West 33 feet and North 23 East 185 feet and South 77 degrees 30 minutes East 66 feet to corner to Clyde Crenshaw; thence with his line North 10 degrees 45 minutes East 355 feet to stone, corner to D. B. Hardy; thence with his line North 76 degrees 45 minutes West 1100 feet and North 13 East 870 feet; thence with line of D. B. Hardy and Robert Haag North 76 degrees 45 minutes West 1920 feet to steel pin at East line of Old County Road, called Old Shelbyville Road in Deed; thence following East right of way line of said Old County Road with its meanders to the beginning.

First Tract: Deed dated January 21, 1972, of record in Deed Book 152, Page 457, in the Office of the Clerk of Bullitt County, Kentucky.


Second Tract: Deed dated October 19, 1962, of record in Deed Book 104, Page 337, in the Office of the Clerk of Bullitt County, Kentucky.

BEING the same property to which Kenneth E. Stout and Donna H. Stout acquired title by deed dated May 4, 1988, from Ruth Porter, which deed is recorded in Deed Book 305, Page 94, in the clerk's office of the Bullitt County Court.

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall be enacted pursuant to KRS 81A.400, et.seq.


SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be published according to law.
