COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKYAN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING ANNEXATION OF UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY
ADJOINING THE CITY OF MT. WASHINGTON, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Mt. Washington, Bullitt County, Kentucky, as follows:

SECTION I: The City Council of the City of Mt. Washington, Bullitt County, Kentucky, does hereby ordain that it confirms the annexation of certain unincorporated territory to the City of Mt. Washington, Bullitt County, Kentucky, as such territory shall become a part of the City for all purposes under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky; and further, such territory annexed is described as follows:

BEGINNING at a post in the south right of way line of Kentucky State Highway No. 44 at the intersection of the west line of a lane or side road, corner to J. M. Stout; thence with the west line of said side road as follows: S 31 $\frac{3}{4}$ E 4.63 chains to a post; S 38 E 2.62 chains to a post S 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 9.64 chains to a stone, corner to Rudell King; thence leaving the road with King's line as follows: S 35 W 12.65 chains to a post; (S 24 W 3.11 chains to a post; S 56 E 3.05 chains to a post, corner to Rudell King in Pearl King's line; thence with Pearl King's S 24 W 14.38 chains to a stone south of a branch, corner to Pearl King in Lewis Armstrong's line; thence with Lewis Armstrong fence N 69 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 21.87 chains to the middle of a branch; thence up the same on the west side as fenced as follows: N 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 1.48 chains; N 30 W 1.40 chains; N 3 W 2/05 chains to a large cedar; N 8 $\frac{3}{4}$ W 1.33 chains to a cedar stump; N 17 W 1.18 chains to a cedar; N 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ E 2.25 chains; N 18 $\frac{3}{4}$ E 1.45 chains; N 22 $\frac{3}{4}$ E 1.30 chains to a post on west bank of a branch; thence up the bluff N 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ E 1.24 chains to a cedar tree, corner to Lewis Mothershead and Curt Harris; thence with Curt Harris along the cliff N 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 6.71 chains to a cedar at a small gate; thence N 40 $\frac{3}{4}$ E 2.75 chains to a stone, corner to Harris; N 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 5.90 chains to a post in the south right of way line of State Highway No. 44, corner to Curt Harris; thence with said south right of way line 30 feet from and parallel to the center line as follows: N 57 $\frac{3}{4}$ E 6.35 chains; N 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 3.72 chains; N 68 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 5.64 chains; N 66 $\frac{3}{4}$ E 6.15 chains to the beginning, containing 82-40/100 acres as per survey made by Curtis Ochs, surveyor of Spencer County, Kentucky, on the 17th day of May 1943.

This is subject to graveyard near the northwest corner of said tract with right of ingress and egress

to and from same and also subject to easement of Salt River Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation

Being the same property conveyed to Oscar Ploetner, et.ux., by Erwin Newman, et.ux., by deed dated December 6, 1949, recorded in Deed Book 75, Page 455, in the office of the Bullitt County Court Clerk.

There is excluded from the above and not conveyed herein that part which was conveyed to Charles Wise and Olivia Wise, by deed from Erwin Newman and Katie B. Newman, dated November 23, 1945, and being of record in Deed Book 68, Page 527, office of the Clerk of the Bullitt County Court, and being a tract of eight acres.

SECTION II: This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to KRS 81A.400, et.seq.

SECTION III: This Ordinance shall be published according to law.

SECTION IV: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.
