AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING ANNEXATION AS SET FORTH IN ORDINANCE 99-17A AND AMENDING THE DESCRIPTION AND PLAT TO CONFORM TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S REQUIREMENTS UNDER THE KENTUCKY REVISED STATUTES

WHEREAS, the City passed, according to law, an Ordinance (99-17) declaring an intent to annex certain property into the City of Mt. Washington on October 25, 1999 and

WHEREAS, the City passed another ordinance on the same date with the same number and to correct the duplication that other Ordinance retains the 99-17 designation and the second Intent Ordinance is now designated 99-17A, *nunc pro tunc*, and

WHEREAS, said property was owed by the City and was part, together with that in Ordinance 99-17, of what would be known as the City of Mt. Washington's Industrial Park, and

WHEREAS, more than 6 months have elapsed since the passing of said declaration of intent and no protests having been filed, and

WHEREAS, there were minor errors in the intent ordinance which are inconsequential as the City was merely annexing what it owned, and

WHEREAS, the Kentucky Secretary of State requires clear and accurate descriptions of property annexed, and

WHEREAS, the city has retained the services of a Registered Land Surveyor to correct such discrepancies, and

WHEREAS, the Surveyor has provided corrected descriptions and plats to the City which accurately reflect the property annexed to the City,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Mt. Washington, Bullitt County, Kentucky, as follows:

SECTION I: The City confirms and hereby Annexes the property set forth in Intent to Annex Ordinance 99-17A as described and depicted in the attached Registered Land Surveyor's corrected and certified plat attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION II: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph or part of this ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance.

SECTION III: The City Clerk is hereby authorized to publish this ordinance in accordance with the Kentucky revised Statutes.

SECTION IV: The City Clerk is hereby directed and authorized to cause the accurate map

and description of the annexed prepared by the Registered Land Surveyor, together with a copy of this ordinance duly certified, to be recorded in the office of the Bullitt County Clerk, in the office of the Secretary of State, and in the Governor's Office for Local Development, and provide to the Bullitt County Court Clerk a list of names and addresses of those property owners and or registered voters, if any within the annexed territory







Enhanced description for Mt Washington Ordinance 99-17A to revise, correct and clarify the original description written by persons unknown:

This property is located in the City of Mt. Washington, Ky., 0.56 miles northwest of Old U.S. Highway 31 E-X and on the roadway now known as Landis Lane.

Beginning at a point in the northern line of the roadway now known as Landis Lane, at the southwest corner of The Meadows Subdivision Revised and recorded in Plat Cabinet 1, Slide 580 in the Bullitt County Clerk's office and also being the southwest corner of the city limits of the City of Mt. Washington, Ky. as established by Ordinance Number 80-5 and also being a northern corner of City of Mt. Washington Ordinance Number 99-17, Tract 5;

Thence with the line of City of Mt. Thence South 35 degrees 05 minutes 26 seconds West 800.12 feet to the point of beginning containing 100.7442 acres excepting out 5.0014 acres formerly conveyed to Joseph and Cindy Wells by Deed Book 365, Page 691 and leaving a total of 95.743 acres as per attached plat dated November 20, 2012 and titled "Enhancement of Ordinance #99-17A" by John A. St. Clair, PLS # 1907.

Being a part of the property conveyed to Live Oaks, Inc by Deed Book 318, Page 072 in the Bullitt County Clerk's office. (Formerly Lunette Landis, Deed Book 70, Page 219)
The original Ordinance No. 99-17A did not list the most current source of title.



AN ORDINANCE PROPOSING ANNEXATION OF UNINCORPORATED
TERRITORY ADJOINING THE CITY OF MT. WASHINGTON,
BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Mt. Washington, Bullitt
County, Kentucky, as follows:

SECTION I: The City Council of the City of Mt. Washington, Bullitt County,
Kentucky, does hereby ordain that it proposes to annex certain unincorporated territory to
the City of Mt. Washington, Bullitt County, Kentucky, and such territory shall become a
part of the City for all purposes under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and
such territory to be annexed is described as follows:

BEGINNING at a large stone at the Southwest corner of McClure's
52.89 acre tract on the North side of a fifteen foot roadway leading to
U.S. Highway No. 31E thence crossing this 15 foot roadway and
continuing with Jack Barnes' lines S 28 $\frac{1}{4}$ W 5.95 chains to a post and
N 53 W 14.28 chains to a post and S 46 $\frac{1}{4}$ W 22.97 chains to a stone
in Jack Barnes, corner to Shelburn, then with Shelburn N 53 $\frac{1}{4}$ W

Washington, Bullitt County, Kentucky, is hereby directed and authorized to give notice of the annexation of this property to the Bullitt County Fiscal Court and to the Secretary of State, Commonwealth of Kentucky.

SECTION VI: The City Clerk is hereby directed and authorized to provide to the Bullitt County Court Clerk a map clearly delineating the boundaries of the area affected along with a list of the names and addresses of those property owners and/or registered voters. The City Clerk is further directed and authorized to provide to the Bullitt county Planning and Zoning Administrator a map clearly showing the zoning for this area and requesting from said administrator a public hearing to discuss said zoning recommendations of the City at a regular meeting of the Bullitt County Planning and Zoning Commission with said publication of meeting according to law.

SECTION VII: Within sixty (60) days of the publication of this Ordinance, _____, 1999, one may petition the Mayor of the City of Mt. Washington for opposition to this Ordinance by having fifty percent (50%) of the registered voters or owners of real property within the limits of the territory proposed to be annexed indicate their opposition to this Ordinance. Said petition must be delivered before _____, 1999, to the Mayor of the City of Mt. Washington, Ed Hilbert, at City Hall, 208 Snapp Street, P.O. Box 285, Mt. Washington, Kentucky 40047.
