DESCRIPTION FOR PROPOSED ANNEXATION

A total of 16.5 acres of land owned by Commonwealth of Kentucky, being the right-of-way of Old US-27 from Station 73+38 to 93+12 (SP-57-8-1), which is the existing City Limit (Tract III A) and the right-of-way from Station 714+89 to Station Equation 722+10.48 Back 100.50.07 Ahead to Station 111+00 (FSP-057-027B-000-006) and 111+00 to 121+14.74 (SSP-57-0027-009-014) which station is the intersection of Baker Lane and US-27; (Tract III B);

and further 9.4 acres of land owned by CNO & TP Railroad being at Baker Lane Railroad intersection Station 3508+09 and extending south to Station 3531+58. (Tract III C)
