

ORDINANCE 268-98

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A DECREE OF ANNEXATION OF
THE HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED PARCEL OF LAND INTO THE CITY
OF NICHOLASVILLE, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, on February 26, 1998 the City of Nicholasville
by and through its Board of Commissioners passed an Ordinance of
Intent to annex all of the property known and described herein as
Exhibit "A";

WHEREAS, no protest or petition has been filed with the Mayor

date of the enactment of the Ordinance of Intent;

Boundary Description
Betsy Simpson Ennis Property

Parcel 1

All that tract or parcel of land bounded on the west by the US 27 By-Pass, to the north by KY. 29 (Wilmore Road) and to the south by the Southern Railway and containing approximately 28.94 Acres.

Parcel 2

All that tract or parcel of land bounded on the west by the Southern Railway, to the north by the City of Nicholasville, et al., to the east by Shun Pike and to the south by Westwood Park Subdivision and containing approximately 16.60 Acres.

Parcel 3

All that tract or parcel of land bounded on the west by the US 27 By-Pass, to the north by Westwood Park Subdivision, to the east by Shun Pike and to the south by Wagner Estates Subdivision and containing approximately 57.66 Acres.
