

ORDINANCE 614-2006

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A DECREE OF ANNEXATION OF
THE HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED PARCEL OF LAND INTO THE CITY
OF NICHOLASVILLE, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, on JULY 13, 2006 the City of Nicholasville
by and through its Board of Commissioners passed an Ordinance of
Intent to annex all of the property known and described herein as
Exhibit "A";

WHEREAS, the owner of the property described in Exhibit "A" has
filed a consent for annexation;

WHEREAS, the City of Nicholasville is still desirous of
extending its corporate city limits by annexing the property known
and described herein as Exhibit "A" and has found that the property
is contiguous with existing corporate city boundaries and will be
useful for municipal purposes;

ANNEXATION FINDINGS

1. The subject property is adjacent and contiguous to the boundaries of the City of Nicholasville and was so at the time of the City's adoption of the Intent to Annex Ordinance (No. 596-2006).

2. The subject property is urban in character and suitable for commercial development without unreasonable delay: (a) due to its location in an existing commercial and industrial area; (b) due to its location inside the urban services boundary of the City; (c) and due to the availability of all utility services to the property.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

MAP II L.L.C.
PROPERTY

A TRACT OF LAND SITUATED TO THE EAST SIDE OF U.S. 27 (NICHOLASVILLE ROAD) IN JESSAMINE COUNTY, KENTUCKY AND MORE FULLY DESCRIBED AND BOUNDED AS FOLLOWS:

Beginning at a point in the eastern right-of-way line of U.S. 27 (Nicholasville Road), said point being approximately 236 feet southwest of the intersection of Turkey Curve Loop and U.S. 27 (Nicholasville Road); thence with the property line N 20-09-32 E, 744.31 feet;; thence with the property line N 18-30-38 E, 329.66 feet; thence with the property line S 73-06-38 E, 143.53 feet; thence with the property line N 50-34-29 E, 84.16 feet; thence with the property line S 70-21-40 E, 118.75 feet; thence with the property line S 29-52-36 W, 63.25 feet; thence with the property line S 62-29-10 E, 844.62 feet; thence with the property line S 35-21-32 W, 571.10 feet; thence with the property line N 64-35-58 W, 837.43 feet; thence with the property line S 35-21-37 W, 529.27 feet to the point of beginning and containing 15.01 acres more or less.


