

ORDINANCE 9-E-8a

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A DECREE OF ANNEXATION
OF THE HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED PARCEL OF LAND INTO
THE CITY OF NICHOLASVILLE, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, on June 8, 1982 the City of Nicholasville by and
through its Board of Commissioners passed an Ordinance of Intent to annex
all of the property known and described herein as Exhibit "A";

WHEREAS, no protest or petition has been filed with the Mayor of the
City of Nicholasville within the sixty (60) days after the date of the
enactment of the Ordinance of Intent;

WHEREAS, the City of Nicholasville is still desirous of extending its
corporate city limits by annexing the property known and described herein
as Exhibit "A";

NOW THEREFORE BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that the property described
herein as Exhibit "A" is annexed into the City Limits of the City of
Nicholasville, Jessamine County, Kentucky.

DO HEREBY SELL, GRANT AND CONVEY unto the parties of the second part, jointly for life as tenants in common with remainder in fee simple to the survivor of them, his or her heirs and assigns, the following described real estate, to wit:

All that tract or parcel of land situated on the westerly side of the Lexington Pike (U. S. Highway No. 27) near Nicholasville, in Jessamine County, Kentucky, and more particularly described and bounded as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a point in the west right of way line of the Lexington Pike (U. S. Highway 27), corner to Otis Phillips; thence with the west right of way line of said pike for three calls S $18^{\circ} 29'$ W 548.5 feet, S $71^{\circ} 31'$ E 10 feet, and S $17^{\circ} 24'$ W 280.1 feet, a new corner to Wilson and Hill; thence for two new lines with Wilson and Hill N $59^{\circ} 41'$ E 171.6 feet to an iron marker and S $33^{\circ} 38'$ W 182.0 feet to an iron marker in the line of Hager; thence with Hager for two lines N $56^{\circ} 50'$ W 238.8 feet and S $31^{\circ} 40'$ W 289.2 feet to a point in the line of Schneider; thence with the line of Schneider and continuing with the line of Strauss N $58^{\circ} 00'$ W 822.4 feet to a point in the east right of way fence of the C.N.O. & T.E. Railroad; thence with the east right of way fence of said railroad for four calls N $06^{\circ} 51'$ E 345.0 feet, N $08^{\circ} 26'$ E 317.0 feet, N $10^{\circ} 07'$ E 354.1 feet and N $11^{\circ} 38'$ E 270.4 feet to a corner with Otis Phillips; thence with the line of Otis Phillips N $61^{\circ} 19'$ E 1529.4 feet to the beginning, and containing 87.27 acres.

Said description being in accordance with survey of subject property made by Cecil C. Harp, Engineers, on February 28, 1961.
