RESOLUTION 012909H

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF TERRITORY PREVIOUSLY ANNEXED BY ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the City of Nicholasville has enacted previous ordinances annexing property into the corporate limits of the City of Nicholasville; and

WHEREAS, the City of Nicholasville wishes to provide an accurate, identifiable legal description reflecting bearings and coordinates based upon the state plane coordinate system, including relevant GPS and GIS data, same having been certified by a professional land surveyor for each prior annexation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Nicholasville wishes to comply with requirements of Amended KRS 81A.470 effective July 13, 2004, and

WHEREAS, the City of Nicholasville does not intend to amend or replace its prior ordinance annexing, but rather to interpret the defined boundaries of the territory previously annexed and adopt an accurate legal description of territory previously annexed.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NICHOLASVILLE, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

That the Board of Commission of the City of Nicholasville hereby adopts the following legal description and a plat attached hereto as prepared by Licensed Professional Land Surveyor No. 2053 by new survey as an accurate depiction of the property previously annexed into the corporate city limits of the City of Nicholasville by Ordinance 11-C-80 dated November 25, 1980, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and hereby adopts said new legal description and plat as the official legal description and plat to be adopted by the City for all purposes when referencing prior annexation.

This new legal description as prepared by William E. McAlpin, Jr. a Licensed Professional Land Surveyor No. 2053 as follows:


