Dear Secretary Mills:

In accordance with S.B. 22, we hereby submit the name of our city, year of incorporation, the current classification and the current boundaries.

City of Northfield
Incorporated - July 20, 1965
5th Class City - March 30, 1978

The current boundaries are essentially as shown in the 1979 Northfield Map prepared by the Kentucky Department of Transportation; drawing by Robert B. Tillett. A word description with general compass directions is as follows:

Starting at the intersection of Route U.S. 42 and Interstate 264 then proceeding southeast on I-264 to an intersection of a southwest extension of Route KY 22, then proceeding northeast on the south edge of Route KY 22 to the intersection of Lime Kiln Lane; thence northwest on the north side of Lime Kiln Lane crossing Route U.S. 42 to the southeast corporate limit of Glenview Manor; thence southwest to the intersection of this boundary line and Glenview Avenue; then progressing northwest on the center line of Glenview Avenue to the intersection of an extension of this line and Interstate 71; thence southwest to the point just beyond the crossover intersection point of I-71 off and on ramps and I-264; thence southeast crossing I-264 and then proceeding on the southwest side of I-264 and up the off ramp to Route U.S. 42; thence back northeast to the intersection of U.S. 42 and I-264.
