ORDINANCE NO. 13-81

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF OWENSBORO, KENTUCKY, CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY IN THE COUNTY OF DAVIESS ADJOINING THE PRESENT BOUNDARY LINE OF THE CITY, BEING PROPERTY LOCATED IN SPRING BANK SUBDIVISION, UNIT NO. 8, CONTAINING 4.42 ACRES, MORE OR LESS.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 114-80, heretofore passed by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Owensboro, Kentucky, on December 12, 1980, the City proposed to annex certain territory hereinafter more particularly described, and

WHEREAS, said ordinance has been published in the official newspaper for the City and more than sixty (60) days have passed since the enactment of said ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF OWENSBORO, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby annexed to the City of Owensboro, Kentucky, and its boundary line is hereby extended so as to include within the limits of the City of Owensboro that certain territory in the County of Daviess, State of Kentucky, adjoining and being adjacent to the present boundary line of the City of Owensboro, Kentucky, more particularly described as follows:


BEGINNING at a stake in the northwest margin of Spring Bank Drive, said stake being in line of the south margin of Woodbridge Trail if extended; thence with the northwest margin of Spring Bank Drive north 39 degrees 36 minutes east 294.0 feet; north 33 degrees 54 minutes east 150.75 feet; north 39 degrees 36 minutes west 192.4 feet to the beginning of a curve to the right; thence continuing with the northwest margin of Spring Bank Drive and its curve to the right 251.0 feet; thence south 77 degrees 04 minutes east 120.0 feet to a stake; thence south 1 degrees 39 minutes east 82.60 feet to a stake in the south-east margin of Spring Bank Drive; thence leaving Spring Bank Drive south 13 degrees 05 minutes west 130.00 feet; north 87 degrees 11 minutes west 124.21 feet; south 74 degrees 21 minutes west 86.62 feet; south 34 degrees 27 minutes west 331.01 feet; south 68 degrees 21 minutes west 60.64 feet; south 40 degrees 38 minutes west 144.98 feet; south 51 degrees 59 minutes west 50.93 feet; north 49 degrees 21 minutes west 175.0 feet to the point of beginning and containing 4.42 acres, more or less.

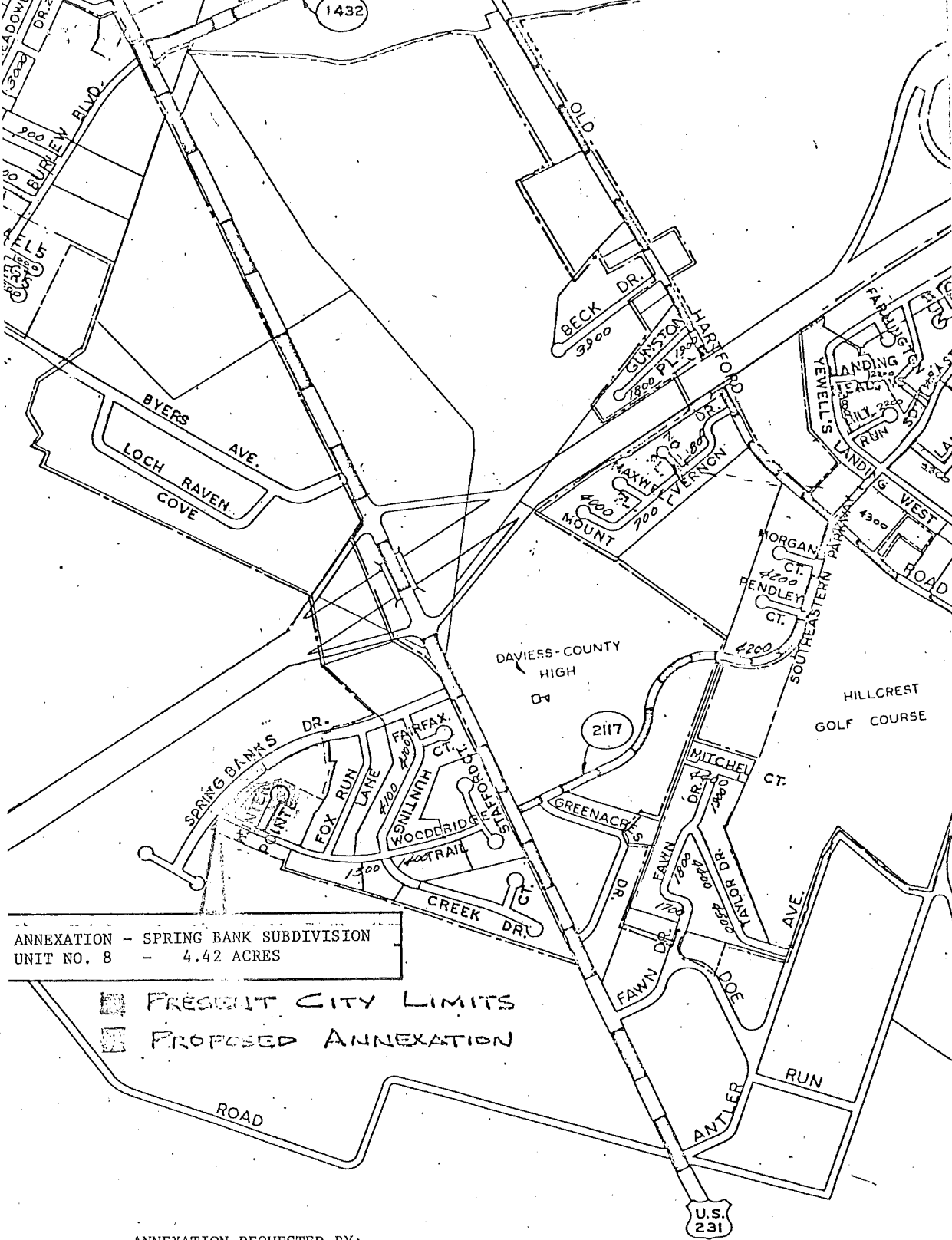
