ORDINANCE NO. 70-90

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF OWENSBORO, KENTUCKY, CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY IN THE COUNTY OF DAVIESS ADJOINING THE PRESENT BOUNDARY LINE OF THE CITY, BEING A PORTION OF 2029 OAK AVENUE, CONTAINING 0.24 OF AN ACRE, MORE OR LESS.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. <u>64-90</u>, heretofore passed by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Owensboro, Kentucky, on <u>November 20</u>, 1990, the City proposed to annex certain territory hereinafter more particularly described, and

WHEREAS, said ordinance has been published in the official newspaper for the city and the sixty (60) day waiting period has been waived in accordance with KRS 81A.412 by virtue of said owners application for annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF OWENSBORO, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby annexed to the City of Owensboro, Kentucky, and its boundary line is hereby extended so as to include within the limits of the City of Owensboro that certain territory in the County of Daviess, State of Kentucky, adjoining and being adjacent to the present boundary line of the City of Owensboro, Kentucky, more particularly described as follows:

> BEGINNING at an iron pipe in the Owensboro Municipal Housing Commission's southwest property line, 15.9 feet northwest of the said Commission's corner, said point also being in the present city limits; thence leaving the present city limits S 75 degrees 52 minutes west 222.8 feet to an iron pipe, corner to Lot 57 of the Lincolnshire Heights Subdivision, said point also being in the present city limits; thence with the present city limits line and with said Lot 57 N 14 degrees 08 minutes W 50 feet to a pipe; thence leaving the present city limits N 75 degrees 52 minutes E 199.38 feet to a pipe in the line of the Housing Commission, said point also being in the present city limits; thence with the present city limits and with said Commission S 39 degrees 07 minutes E 55.2 feet to the point of beginning and containing 0.24 acres, more or less.

SECTION 2. Any dedicated streets, alleys, or easements constituting any portion of the property to be annexed are hereby accepted by the City of Owensboro pursuant to KRS 82.400.
