## ORDINANCE NO. 8-93

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AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF OWENSBORO, KENTUCKY, CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY IN THE COUNTY OF DAVIESS ADJOINING THE PRESENT BOUNDARY LINE OF THE CITY, BEING PROPERTY LOCATED AT 1217 AND 4200 SPRING BANK DRIVE - CONTAINING 6.042 ACRES, MORE OR LESS.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. <u>4-93</u>, heretofore passed by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Owensboro, Kentucky, on <u>February 16</u>, 19<u>93</u>, the City proposed to annex certain territory hereinafter more particularly described, and

WHEREAS, said ordinance has been published in the official newspaper for the city and the sixty (60) day waiting period has been waived in accordance with KRS 81A.412 by virtue of said owners application for annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF OWENSBORO, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby annexed to the City of Owensboro, Kentucky, and its boundary line is hereby extended so as to include within the limits of the City of Owensboro that certain territory in the County of Daviess, State of Kentucky, adjoining and being adjacent to the present boundary line of the City of Owensboro, Kentucky, more particularly described as follows:

> at an iron pipe found at the BEGINNING intersection of the western right-of-way line of Spring Bank Drive and the northern right-of-way line of Woodbridge Trail; thence with the northern right-of-way line of Woodbridge Trail North 51 degrees 17 minutes 40 seconds West 387.78 feet to an iron pipe found in the rightof-way line of the U.S. 60 Bypass; thence with said right-of-way line the following four (4) North 52 degrees 33 minutes 31 seconds calls: East 375.99 feet to an iron pipe found; North 57 degrees 32 minutes 20 seconds East 387.78 feet to an iron pipe found; North 60 degrees 21 minutes 47 seconds East 69.84 feet to an iron pipe set this survey; North 60 degrees 21 minutes 47 seconds East 185.00 feet to an iron pin found at the corner of a previous purchase tract line within the present city limit adjacent to the Spring Bank Towne Houses property; thence with said line and the present city limit South 29 degrees 36 minutes East 332.38 feet to an iron pipe set in the right-ofway of Spring Bank Drive; thence with said

right-of-way the following twelve (12) calls: North 77 degrees 22 minutes 58 seconds West 123.83 feet to an iron pipe set; North 80 degrees 48 minutes 57 seconds West 30.94 feet to an iron pipe set; South 89 degrees 22 minutes 55 seconds West 41.22 feet to a P.K. nail set; South 81 degrees 15 minutes 56 seconds West 33.97 feet to an iron pipe set; South 72 degrees 07 minutes 07 seconds West 7.99 feet to an iron pipe set this survey; South 69 degrees 07 minutes 16 seconds West 41.33 feet to an iron pipe set this survey; South 58 degrees 42 minutes 13 seconds West 44.21 feet to an iron pin found; South 50 degrees 11 minutes 11 seconds West 24.98 feet to an iron pin found; South 42 degrees 10 minutes 14 seconds West 30.37 feet to an iron pin found; South 39 degrees 13 minutes 12 seconds West 192.40 feet to an iron pin found; South 33 degrees 28 minutes 51 seconds West 150.76 feet to an iron pin found; South 39 degrees 11 minutes 29 seconds West 244.07 feet to the point of beginning and containing 6.042 acres, more or less.

SECTION 2. Any dedicated streets, alleys, or easements constituting any portion of the property to be annexed are hereby accepted by the City of Owensboro pursuant to KRS 82.400.
