AN ORDINANCE establishing the Corporate Limits of the City of Park City, Kentucky, and annexing certain territory to the City.

WHEREAS, the City of Park City has previously passed, approved, and adopted on the 19th day of November, 1976, an ordinance proposing to extend the corporate limits of the City of Park City, Kentucky, and annexing certain territory to the city; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance was published in the Glasgow, Kentucky, Daily Times, a daily publication having the largest circulation in Barren County, Kentucky, and more than thirty days have expired since the adoption and approval of the proposal to extend the corporate limits of the City of Park City, Kentucky, and annex certain territory to the city; and

WHEREAS, no petition has been filed in the Barren Circuit Court as provided in Kentucky Revised Statutes 81.110 setting forth the reasons why the territory or any part of it should not be annexed;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Board of Trustees (Board of Aldermen); (General Council); (Common Council); (City Council); (Board of Trustees) OF THE CITY OF Park City, Kentucky:

SECTION I: That the corporate limits of the City of Park City, Kentucky, as now established, be extended so as to embrace the territory hereinafter accurately described, and to annex the territory hereinafter described to the said City of Park City, Kentucky, viz:

Beginning at the intersection of the L&N Railroad tracks and the existing Southwestern Cooperate Limits of Park City, Kentucky thence following the railroad tracks \$73019'W 812.5' thence turning and going parallel to the existing Southwestern Cooperate limits N16° 17'44"W 4062.5'; thence turning and going parallel to the existing Northwestern Cooperate Limits N73042'16"E 1875.0', to the center line of Kentucky Highway 255; thence along said highway the following calls: \$24022'E 125.01, \$44021'E 750.01, \$17945'E 312.5', and S27057'E 312.5' to the existing Northwestern Cooperate Limit of Park City; thence turning and following the existing Cooperate Limit the following calls: \$73°42'16'W 1502.0', and \$16°17'44'E 2650.0' to the point of beginning. Said tract containing 118.51 acres.

SECTION II: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval, and publication, and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed and held for naught.
