## ORDINANCE DE-ANNEXING TERRITORY



## THE TOWN OF PARK CITY, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS; the Town Board of Trustees of the Town of Park City, Barren County, Kentucky, has previously, by Ordinance No. 117, stated its intention to de-annex certain territory in said city hereinafter described; and,

WHEREAS, said ordinance was duly published in the Glasgow Daily Times in accordance with Chapter 424 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes on March 11, 1977; and,

WHEREAS, more than thirty (30) days has elapsed since the enactment of said ordinance following publication of its adoption, and no petition or remonstrance has been filed in the Barren Circuit Court protesting said de-annexation;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Town Board of Trustees of Park City, Kentucky, does hereby de-annex and remove from the limits of Park City, Kentucky, the following described territory:

> Being a certain parcel of land located within the city limits of Park City, Kentucky, containing 92.23 acres, as same is currently established, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe on the north side of U.S. 31-W, said point being a corner to the Southern States property; thence crossing over said 31-W S 12 degrees 35' E 1168.02 feet; thence S 72 degrees 21' W 2807.10 ft. to a post; thence S 72 degrees 2102' E 967.63 ft; thence N 75 degrees 14' E 2264.97 ft. to the point of beginning containing \$2.23 acres, more or less.

A map of the territory de-annexed from the Town of Park City is on file with the City Clerk.

This ordinance shall be published in the Glasgow Daily Times in accordance with Chapter 424 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes.
