Dear Secretary:

Pursuant to KRS 81.045, we submit herewith an up-to-date record of the incorporation of the City of Parkway Village, Jefferson County, Kentucky, sixth-class city, the filing with the Secretary of State's office, within one year of the effective date of the said action, the following:

1. Ballwey, Albert F. Weller, William R. Markuert, and 393 other persons, entered in the Judgment Book 90, Page 2, in the Office of the Jefferson County Court Clerk, dated August 14, 1940, and

2. A certified copy of Jefferson Circuit Court, in the above-styled and captioned action, a map and plot plan of the present boundaries of the City of Parkway Village.

JUDGMENT

This proceeding came on for hearing and was heard and submitted and it appearing to the Court from the record herein that notice of the filing of the petition herein and the object thereof has been published on July 25, 1940, and on July 26, 1940, in two issues of the Louisville Times, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in Jefferson County, Kentucky and it further appearing to the Court being satisfied from the verified petition that the population within the boundary hereinafter described is more than one hundred twenty-five persons and that the said boundary is square, and that more than two-thirds of the voters within said area have signed the petition to incorporate, it is ordered and adjudged that a town be and is hereby established as a municipal corporation to be named and known as Parkway Village within the following described boundary, as shown by the description filed herein, viz:

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of Preston Street Road with a line in Clark's Lane 15 feet northwardly of and parallel to the front lines of lots abutting Clark's Lane in Parkway Village Subdivision; thence with the center line of Preston Street Road southwardly 2112.91 feet more or less to the intersection of the center line of Preston Street Road with the southerly boundary line extended of Homeland Subdivision; thence northeastwardly along such southerly boundary of Homeland Subdivision 1005.31 feet more or

less to the southeast corner of Homeland Subdivision in Pearce's Line; thence northwardly along the easterly line of Homeland Subdivision and said line extended to the southeast corner of Preston Place Subdivision; thence northwardly along the easterly line of Preston Place Subdivision and the easterly line of Reading Road Subdivision and the easterly line of Parkway Village Subdivision and said line extended to a point in a line in Clark's Lane 15 feet northwardly of and parallel to the front lines of lots in Parkway Village Subdivision abutting on Clark's Lane; thence southwardly along said line in Clark's Lane 15 feet northwardly of and parallel to the front lines of lots in Parkway Village Subdivision abutting Clark's Lane 1203.8 feet more or less to the beginning.

And it further appearing to the Court that each of the persons hereinafter named are suitable and eligible under the law to become officers of said town and each resides within the above described boundary and the Court being advised, it is ordered that Sam F. Messer, Albert F. Weller, Irvin G. Ballway, Oliver Brown and Fred M. McGrath go and they are each appointed a member of the Board of Trustees of said town; that Roy T. Fennell be and he is appointed Police Judge of said town; that John C. Hackel be and he is appointed Marshal of said town; and Daniel E. Gray be and he is appointed Assessor for said town; each of named persons shall hold their respective offices until the next election at which officers for cities and towns may be elected. Said officers shall qualify as prescribed by law and a record of their respective oath and qualification shall be entered upon the records of said town and attested copies of the records thereof certified to this Court and filed in this proceeding.
