

ORDINANCE NO.
11-15-82-3

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING SAID AREA BY THE CITY OF PEMBROKE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

Pursuant to Kentucky Revised Statutes Section 81A.410, the City of Pembroke Board of Commissioners is annexing said area. A true and accurate copy of a survey is attached which defines the boundaries of the unincorporated territory to be annexed; said survey is incorporated fully herein by reference.

SECTION II

The area annexed is:

- A. Adjacent to current City of Pembroke boundaries and has contiguous boundaries to the current City of Pembroke City Limits at the time of these annexation proceedings;
- B. Urban in character and suitable for further development by reason of population density; commercial, industrial, institutional use of the land.

SECTION III

No part of the said area is included within the boundaries of another city.

SECTION IV

The City of Pembroke has complied with all statutory provisions for annexation set forth in 81A.420.

SECTION V


Upon the enactment of this ordinance, the said area shall become part of the city for all purposes.

SECTION VI

Should any section or provision of this ordinance be decided by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or part thereof other than the part declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.

ORDINANCE 8-16-82-2

The Pembroke Board of Commissioners, on August 16, 1982, adopted an Ordinance of Intent to Annex.

The proposed annexation beginning at a point along the existing corporate city limits approximately 900 feet south-east of the center of the intersection of Spring Street and Dewey Street, thence S59°45'E 1550 feet, thence S27°15'W 2625 feet, thence S32°45'E 450 feet, thence S24°00'W 360 feet, thence N86°45'W 1310 feet, thence N34°30'E 180 feet, thence N25°00'W 455 feet, thence N00°15'S 530 feet, thence N47°00'W 575 feet, thence N34°15'W 620 feet, thence N34°15'W 1100 feet, thence N79°00'E 590 feet, thence S32°45'E 435 feet, thence N56°00'E 1055 feet, thence N34°00'E 650 feet to a point along the existing corporate city limits approximately 1150 feet south of Main Street at the North Fork, Montgomery Creek. The area encompassed by this description and boundary is approximately 163.57 acres or 0.26 square miles and includes the Hails Avenue area and approximately .02 of a mile along Mason Lane.
