ORDINANCE NO. 96-01

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN
PROPERTY BORDERING THE BOUNDARY
OF THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY
OF PLEASUREVILLE, KENTUCKY

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PLEASUREVILLE, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Pleasureville, Kentucky, having considered it to be in the best interest of the City to facilitate the growth and development of the community, and hereby declaring that it is desirable to annex the unincorporated territory more particularly described below, the Commission of the City of Pleasureville, Kentucky does hereby ordain as follows:

The City of Commission does hereby annex the following tract of land described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of the L&N Railroad corner to the lot of W.H. Gordon (now Eugene Kelly); thence with said L&N railroad in a westerly direction 144 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to the James Warren property; thence in a northerly direction 293 feet corner to Anderson Frazier; thence in an easterly direction 162 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet with Frazier's line corner to Eugene Kelly; thence in a southerly direction 332 feet to the beginning.
